

COVID-19 TESTING PILOT PROGRAM

Reimbursements available for \$35/person tested

The COVID-19 Testing Pilot Program provides payments to Wisconsin organizations that conduct eligible COVID-19 testing (for example, specimen collection and result communication) in community-based settings, outbreak-based settings, and in high-risk congregate settings.

Eligible parties may receive \$35 per person tested, including results communication, for testing conducted between August 13 and November 15, 2020, or until funds are exhausted.

Easy, online application

Applying is easy! All entities that apply for the COVID-19 Testing Pilot Program are required to complete:

- A program application (**[F-02704, COVID-19 Testing Pilot Application](#)**).
- Proof of partnership with local/tribal health departments related to proposed testing site. Partnership can be documented via email correspondence, memo of understanding, or other documented agreement.

Both the application and corresponding partnership documentation should be submitted via email to the **dhscovidtestingprogram@dhs.wisconsin.gov**.

Eligible providers:

- Any public health department.
- Any health care provider licensed by the State of Wisconsin.
- Other individuals or organizations trained in specimen collection under the authority and oversight of a physician.



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
