## Where We Are

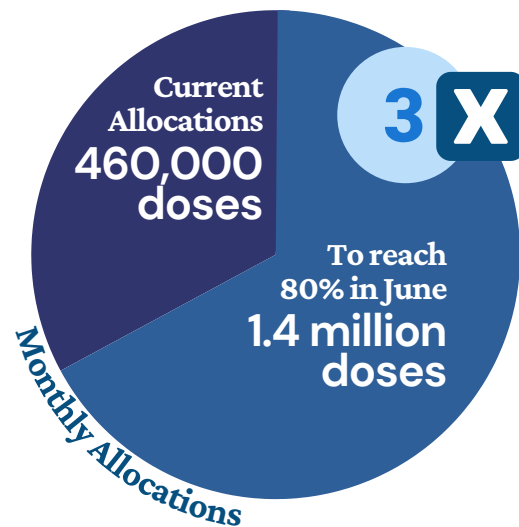
It's been barely a month since the first COVID-19 vaccine received Emergency Use Authorization, and we've come a long way in that time. We have two **safe and effective** vaccines, we have developed protocols and **processes for distribution**, vaccinations have started for Phase 1A frontline health care workers, staff and residents of long-term care facilities, adults 65 and older, and police and fire personnel, the **State Disaster Medical Advisory Committee** has made **recommendations** for populations to include in Phase 1B, and we continue to refine our system and enhance our transparency with **vaccine data** updates.

The COVID-19 vaccine is the most significant public health intervention this state has ever embarked upon, and we at DHS are working hard to get vaccine in arms safely, quickly, and equitably, with the goal of vaccinating at least 80% of Wisconsin residents by June 2021. To achieve that goal, we need more vaccine. A lot more.
