- This <u>quick guide</u> and <u>checklist</u> will help school administrators keep track of deadlines and school immunization law requirements during the first 90 days of school.
- <u>Immunization requirements</u> for attending school (public and private) in Wisconsin differ by age and grade.
 - Parents can reference the following school immunization requirements for <u>kindergarten through fifth grade</u> and <u>sixth through twelfth grade</u>.
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommend that all children receive these immunizations to best protect themselves and their peers.
- The <u>Vaccines for Children Program</u> is a resource for families in need of low or no-cost immunizations for their children. There are <u>providers available</u> throughout the state.

The State of Wisconsin does not mandate COVID-19 vaccination in any setting. Individuals will need to check with their school districts to understand the masking and vaccination rules that pertain to their school.
