Overlapping CCS Services

What are CCS overlapping services?

Overlapping services are CCS services that are provided to a consumer who has been admitted into a hospital or hospital setting for care.

When should CCS services be paused for a CCS consumer when they are an inpatient?

Once the consumer has been admitted and is an inpatient of the hospital or in a hospital setting, then all CCS services should be paused.

Who is responsible for the care of the CCS consumer once admitted as an inpatient?

The hospital staff will assume care for the consumer once admitted into the hospital.

When should a CCS provider resume CCS services for their consumer?

When the consumer is ready for hospital discharge, then the CCS provider can resume services to prepare the consumer for discharge from the facility to reside in the community.
