


Health Care Confidentiality for Teens

What is confidentiality?

Confidentiality means that anything told to a health care provider will not be repeated to anyone outside of the health care team, unless there is reason to believe someone is in immediate danger.

What services can teens get confidentially?

- Contraceptive services
- STI and HIV testing and treatment

When might your information be shared?

- To receive health services that require parental consent
- When your health care provider is concerned about your safety

How can parents and guardians help?

- By giving teens privacy
- By providing teens with responsibilities

How can health care providers help?

- By creating a comfortable atmosphere for their patients
- By asking parents to step out of the room
