# Birth to 3 Family Experience Survey: What Families Need to Know

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) invites families to tell us about their experience in the Birth to 3 Program in order to help us learn about what is going well and to find ways to make the program stronger for families throughout Wisconsin.

### Who receives the Family Experience Survey?

The Family Experience Survey is sent to all families of children when they leave the Birth to 3 Program. Surveys are sent approximately one month after the child exits the Birth to 3 Program.

#### How to complete the survey

#### Paper

Families receive a printed copy of the Family Experience Survey that can be mailed back to DHS. Families may complete the paper survey and use the self-addressed, postage-paid envelope to return the survey by U.S. mail free of charge.

#### Online

Families can also complete the survey online. Using a computer, smartphone, or tablet, families may complete the survey at the link provided in the cover letter.

Families are asked to complete the survey within 30 days.

#### Questions to expect

The Family Experience Survey includes 21 questions regarding whether the Birth to 3 Program has helped the family in:

- Knowing and understanding their rights.
- Effectively communicating their children's needs.
- Helping their children develop and learn.

Questions are based on a five-point scale, ranging from 1=not at all helpful to 5=extremely helpful. It takes about 5-10 minutes to complete the survey.

## Why the Family Experience Survey matters and how information from the Survey is used

DHS values parent and caregiver feedback. Receiving input from families served in the Birth to 3 Program allows DHS to understand how early intervention is working and where improvements can be made.

The results of the Family Experience Survey are reported in a required annual performance report to the US Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP). The report is available for viewing at <u>https://osep.grads360.org/#report/apr/publicView</u>.



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
