Introducing Wisconsin's Asthma-Safe Homes Program



In-Home Asthma Education

What we do

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services' Asthma-Safe Homes Program works to improve asthma and reduce disparities for Medicaideligible children and pregnant adults with uncontrolled asthma. The program serves Milwaukee, Racine, Kenosha, Rock, and Brown counties.

The two-part program promotes asthma selfmanagement and healthy living environments through:

- 1. In-home asthma education and home supplies.
- 2. Environmental services including a detailed home assessment, repairs, and remediation of trigger sources.

Participants saw a **35% reduction** in asthmarelated emergency department visits and hospitalizations. They also report **better asthmacontrol** and **fewer missed school or work days**.
