


## Creating a Document of Age-Dependent ADL and IADL Questions (FSIA)

These instructions show how create a PDF document with age-dependent instrumental activities of daily living (IADL) and activities of daily living (ADL) questions.


1. Log into FSIA and click on the "Reports" tab.




## 2. Click on "Forms."




3. Click on "Children's Long Term Supports Age-Specific ADL and IADL Questions."




4. Enter the child's Birth Date.




5. Enter the Screen Begin Date.
