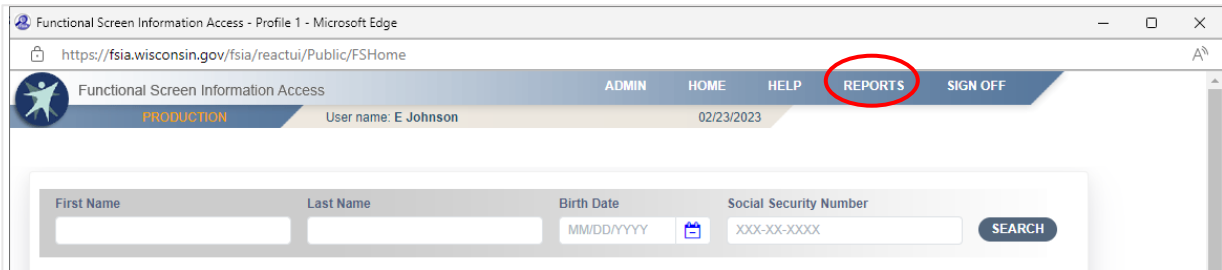


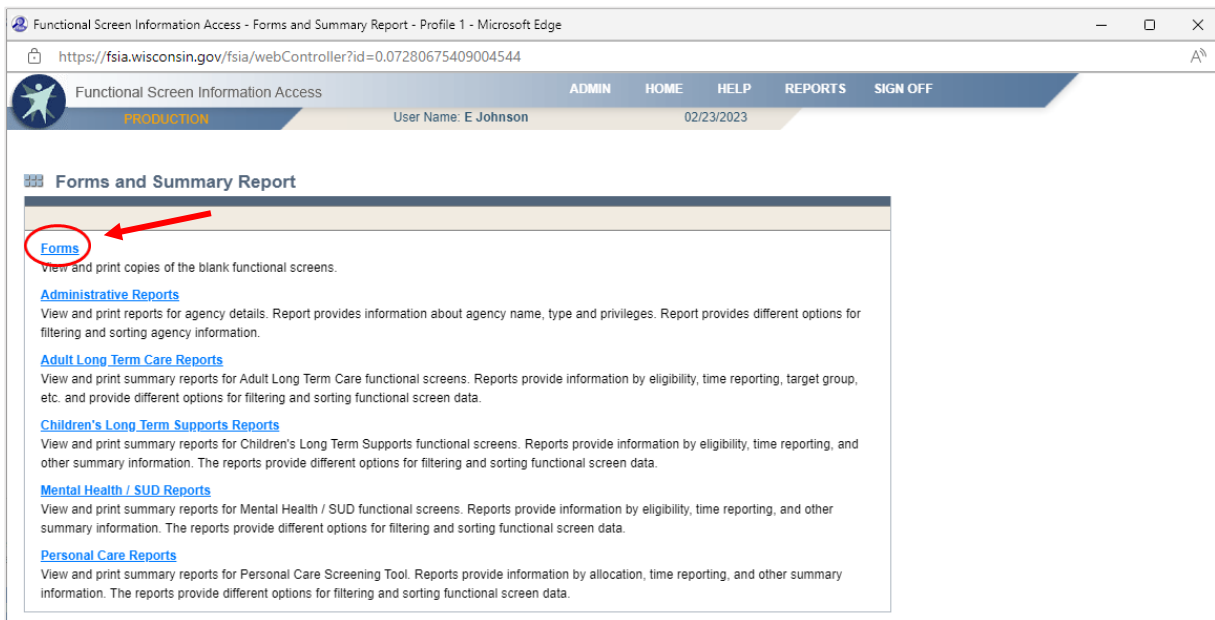
Creating a Document of Age-Dependent ADL and IADL Questions (FSIA)

These instructions show how create a PDF document with age-dependent instrumental activities of daily living (IADL) and activities of daily living (ADL) questions.

1. Log into FSIA and click on the “Reports” tab.



2. Click on “Forms.”
