Take these steps to treat your hepatitis C




Call 211 for information on Medicaid and other insurance options or text your zip code to 898211.



Visit a primary care doctor and talk about your hepatitis C diagnosis.



Take your hepatitis C medication for 8-12 weeks.



Retest when you've finished treatment to make sure the infection is gone.




Make sure you are vaccinated against hepatitis A and hepatitis B.

Flip to learn how to protect yourself from hepatitis C

Keep Hepatitis C in the Past

You can become infected with hepatitis C again.



Do not share syringes and other drug use equipment with others.



Practice safe sex and always use condoms.



Avoid blood-to-blood contact with others.
