



Are you uninsured or does your health insurance not cover the costs of the **COVID-19 vaccine**? The Bridge Access Program can help you get one at **no cost**.



Who is eligible for the Bridge Access Program (BAP)?

You are eligible for the BAP if you are at least 19 years old and are either:

- ► Uninsured: You do not have health insurance.
- Underinsured: You have health insurance but it does not cover all COVID-19 vaccine costs at in-network health care providers.

Those under 19 may be eligible for COVID-19 vaccines through the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program.

Where can I go to get a COVID-19 vaccine through the BAP?

- ➤ You can get a free COVID-19 vaccine at participating health care providers, federally qualified health centers (FQHC), and pharmacies.
