Home and Community-Based Services Settings Rule


Supporting Your Independence

The Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Settings Rule promotes independent living and community inclusion for Medicaid members.



People getting Medicaid HCBS have the right to:

- **Experience full access to the community.** This includes chances to seek employment and work in integrated settings, take part in community life, control money, and get services in the community.
- **Decide where they live.** Options include non-disability-specific locations. Their long-term care support team provides options based on their needs, preferences, and resources.
- **Be treated with dignity and respect.** They have the right to privacy and freedom from threats and restraint.
- **Live with independence.** They can make choices about life, daily activities, friendships, the places they go, and more.
- Choose services and supports and who provides them.
