Reading a Disinfectant Label

Disinfectant labels are printed on or attached to the product container. Labels provide valuable information on how to use the product properly. It is important to read and understand the instructions for use before using a disinfectant product.

Proper preparation

Ensure product is prepared according to the instructions. Following instructions meticulously will assure that the disinfection occurs as expected.

Targeted pathogens

Ensure that the pathogens being targeted is included in the product's kill claim.

Targeted surfaces

Ensure the disinfectant is only used on approved surfaces according to the disinfectant's instructions for use.

Contact time

Also referred to as "dwell time," "kill time," or "wet time." Contact time provides the amount of time a surface needs to remain wet with a disinfectant product to achieve adequate disinfection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Concentrated product should not be used. **Dilute properly before using.**

Dilute four (4) ounces of concentrated product per one (1) gallon of water. Once prepared, solution expires after 48 hours.

To disinfect hard, nonporous surfaces:
