

Know the Signs of cCMV



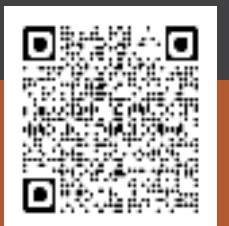
Congenital cytomegalovirus, or cCMV, is a leading cause of hearing loss and other birth defects. However, when the virus is caught early, most babies do well.

That's why it's so important to test for cCMV in your newborn's first three weeks if they have any of the signs below:

- **Failed hearing screening**
- **An unexplained premature birth**
- **A small head and/or body for their age**
- **A red pinpoint rash or jaundice**
- **Seizures**
