

Federal Medicaid Work Requirement:

This takes effect
January 1, 2027,
but does not apply
to current members
until their next
renewal starting
March 2027.

What does the work requirement mean for someone with a disability?



**The new federal work requirement only applies to some
Medicaid members enrolled in BadgerCare Plus.**

If you have a disability determination from the Social Security Administration, you don't have to meet the work requirement.

If you don't have a disability determination or you are waiting for one, but you receive services through one of Wisconsin's long-term care programs (Family Care, Partnership, IRIS, or PACE), you don't have to meet the work requirement.

**If you don't have a disability determination or are waiting for one, but you have a serious
or complex medical condition** that affects your ability to work, you don't need to meet the work requirement.
