Temporary Health Insurance for Children

Temporary health insurance for children age 18 and younger is available through BadgerCare Plus. If you have children and limited income, your children may be able to get temporary health insurance, for up to two months, quickly before you apply for ongoing BadgerCare Plus through your county or tribal agency.

Temporary health insurance for children will pay for services such as:

- Doctor Visits
- Immunizations
- Prescription drugs
- Lab and x-ray services
- Dental care

And much more!

Your family's gross monthly income must be at or under the income limit for temporary health insurance and you must meet all other program rules.

How To Get Temporary Health Care

If you already have a health care provider, call and ask if s/he can use Express Enrollment to help your children get temporary health insurance through BadgerCare Plus.

If you don't have a provider, call 1-800-362-3002 and they will find a BadgerCare Plus provider for you. They can also tell you what organizations in your area can use Express Enrollment to get you temporary health insurance.

If you get enrolled, your child's temporary health insurance will start the same day you apply with your child's BadgerCare Plus provider. Your child's benefits will continue through the last day of the next month.

For example: If the BadgerCare Plus provider enrolls your child on June 6, your child's coverage lasts until July 31.

Apply Today!

Because temporary BadgerCare Plus lasts 60 days or less, you should apply for regular BadgerCare Plus with your agency as soon as possible.
