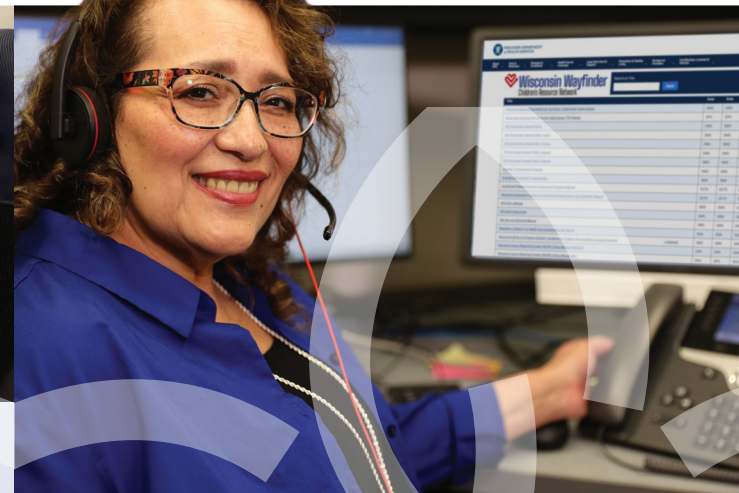

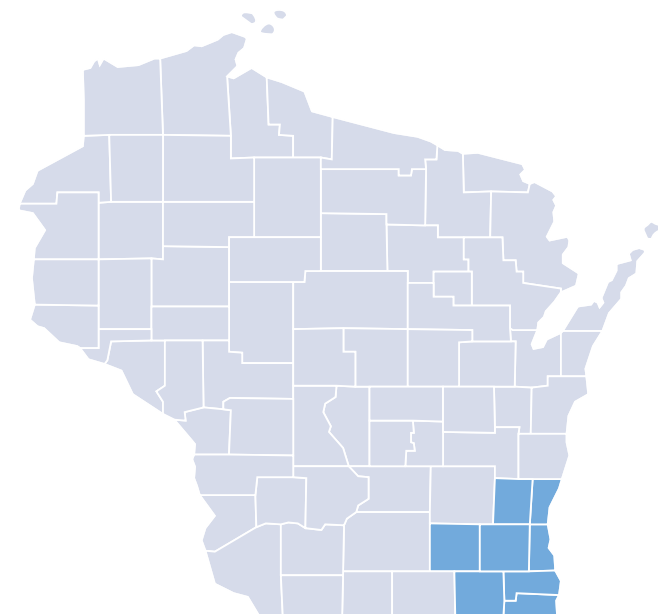
Guiding Wisconsin families of children and youth with special health care needs
