

Notice of Exclusion

Dear Parent:

The attached notice indicates that your child is currently not in compliance with the Wisconsin Student Immunization Law and therefore will be excluded from this school on

For your child to remain at school or re-enter school after exclusion, you must do one of the following:

- (1) Provide this school with the date (month, day, and year) of the required immunization(s) either from your child's medical records or from the [Wisconsin Immunization Registry](#). Exceptions to the varicella (chickenpox) vaccine will be allowed only if a physician, physician assistant, or advanced nurse prescriber document a reliable history of varicella disease by indicating that the student has had varicella and signing the Student Immunization Form ([DHS Form 04020L](#)). Laboratory evidence of immunity is also acceptable for these diseases: measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis B, and varicella.

OR

- (2) Claim a waiver.

Use the attached Student Immunization Record to provide the information described above.

The Immunization Law in Wisconsin was passed to protect all children from vaccine-preventable diseases. The law requires public schools in school districts with less than a 99% compliance level to exclude noncompliant students in kindergarten through grade five. The law also applies to private schools. Private schools with less than a 99% compliance level are required to exclude noncompliant students in kindergarten through grade five. A noncompliant student is one who is "behind schedule" for a required immunization(s), or has no immunization record on file at the school and does not have a waiver on file.
