REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Coordinated Services Teams Initiative funding are to be used to provide a wraparound approach for children, with priority given to children with a severe emotional disturbance involved in multiple systems as established in Wis.Stat 46.56. All aspects of 46.56 should be followed and matching funds in the amount of 20% are to be provided by the County. Reports on progress and fiscal expenditure, including match, are to be submitted to the Bureau of Prevention Treatment and Recovery as outlined in the CST Appendix, including an annual fiscal report which identifies County required match expenditures which must be submitted to the BPTR within 60 days after the calendar year of program operations in a format provided by the BPTR. Counties should report allowable costs minus match amounts to CARS. Restrictions on funding use include no funding of inpatient services, no cash payments to recipients, no purchase or improvement of land, construction, or facilities, no purchase of major medical equipment, or to provide financial assistance to any entity other

than a public or nonprofit private entity.
