DHS staff will then upload, to this CARS Profile, applicable funeral and cemetery expenses for members of certain categories of Medicaid and other qualifying individuals as referenced in Section 1.1 of the WFCAP manual who were not part of the W-2 group. These expenses will then be reimbursed on CARS Profile 105. See DHS Administrator's Memo 06-03 for more details.

Per case funeral expenses for members who were not a part of the W-2 group are limited to the lesser of \$1,500 or any amount not paid by the person's estate or by other persons. Funeral expenses include all costs associated with the goods/services that it, or other funeral homes in the same corporation, provided, whether those goods and services were provided before death or after death.

Per case cemetery expenses for members who were not a part of the W-2 group are limited to the lesser of \$1,000 or any amount not paid by the person's estate or by other persons. Cemetery expenses include all costs associated with the goods/services that the cemetery and/or crematorium provided, whether those goods and services were provided before death or after death.
