Pregnant women and persons who inject drugs must be given priority in treatment admissions. This funding must be used as the payment of last resort for treatment services for pregnant women and women with dependent children. Other restrictions on the use of federal Substance Abuse Block Grant (SABG) funds also apply to this profile. The tribes are required to submit bi-annual performance reports.
