Wisconsin's Trauma Care System is dedicated to reducing the death, disability, and suffering that results from traumatic injuries or mass casualty events by providing a comprehensive and integrated system of statewide prevention and trauma care resources throughout the continuum of care. A successful statewide trauma care system includes the establishment of regions that are data drive, confidential and sensitive to the needs and limitations of each regional area. The goals of regional planning include: 1) the integration of all hospitals into an inclusive network to provide definitive care to all injured patients in Wisconsin, 2) to collect and analyze data in a systematic way in order to modify and evaluate the regional trauma system, 3) to assess the appropriateness of trauma care standards and develop injury prevention strategies, and 4) to assess the extent of resources needed to sustain the regional system.
