PROFILE DESCRIPTION: Hudson Hospital and Clinic working in collaboration and contract with county DHS 34, Subchapter III Emergency Mental Health Service programs (known as Crisis Intervention programs) will provide in-person and/or mobile Crisis Intervention services through a three-county region (of Pierce, Polk, and St. Croix) across seven partner hospital emergency departments. Certified DHS 34 telehealth services will provide the vehicle for mobile outreach from Hudson Hospital to six partner hospital emergency departments. Services will be provided seven days per week during the busiest hours of emergency department utilization, specifically the hours of 10 a.m. to 2 a.m. the next day.
