Summary: Tribal Income Maintenance agencies receive funding for processing of applications, reviews, changes and other tasks related to eligibility determination for the FoodShare Program, Medicaid (MA) and BadgerCare Programs, FoodShare Employment and Training (FSET) and Caretaker Supplement Program. The 2019 Wisconsin Act 9 Budget allocated an additional \$74,666 to Tribal IM agencies in SFY 2021. These amounts are intended to be spent on implementing FSET drug screening and testing, enforcing new FSET able-bodied adult eligibility requirements, enforcing new MA eligibility requirements related to childless adult waivers, and for health savings accounts under MA. This profile ID will cover the federal share of this new funding for Tribes.
