

New Program Announcement!

Recovery Housing Voucher Initiative

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) and the Wisconsin Department of Administration (DOA) are collaborating to make recovery housing vouchers available to individuals with opioid use disorder. DHS will allocate \$2 million in funds to create a new voucher program, overseen by DOA to support individuals in recovery who are experiencing or at risk for homelessness. These vouchers will pay for rent at recovery residencies registered through DHS. A grant process will be available to agencies with a recovery residency in the region they serve. Each agency is eligible for up to \$100,000 per year depending on expected number of individuals served.
