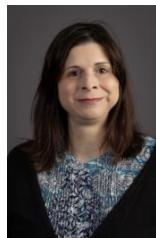

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CBRF CURRICULUM REVISION & IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE

- **2025:** UW-Green Bay and DHS/BAL collaborated with stakeholders to update all state-mandated CBRF training curricula
- **March 2026:** Pilot implementation launched with select instructors teaching the revised courses to UW-Green Bay staff
- **Spring 2026:** Course delivery data was analyzed to determine updated minimum instructional time requirements.
- **May 25, 2026:** Revised curricula released to all approved instructors
- **June 1, 2026:** Statewide implementation of the updated curricula began.



CURRICULUM UPDATES

First Aid and Choking & Standard Precautions

- Primarily limited to updated language (e.g., “provider” instead of “doctor”, “community” instead of “facility”, etc.).

Fire Safety

- Removed some of the more advanced firefighting content to better align with the focus on recognizing and responding, which more accurately reflects what care staff are expected to do.

Medication Administration

- The most notable change was replacing the fill-in medication class tables with pre-populated tables featuring common medications participants are likely to encounter. This was also shifted to a discussion-based activity.



TIME REQUIREMENT ADJUSTMENTS

First Aid and Choking: 4 hours (*no change*)

Standard Precautions: 2 hours (*no change*)

Fire Safety: 2.5 hours (*previously 3 hours*)

Medication Administration: 10 hours 15 minutes (*previously 14 hours taught over two days*)

- This class must be taught over a minimum of **two days** and is best divided into sections. Sections I, II, and III should be covered on the first day, with Section IV plus the skills and knowledge test completed on the second day.
