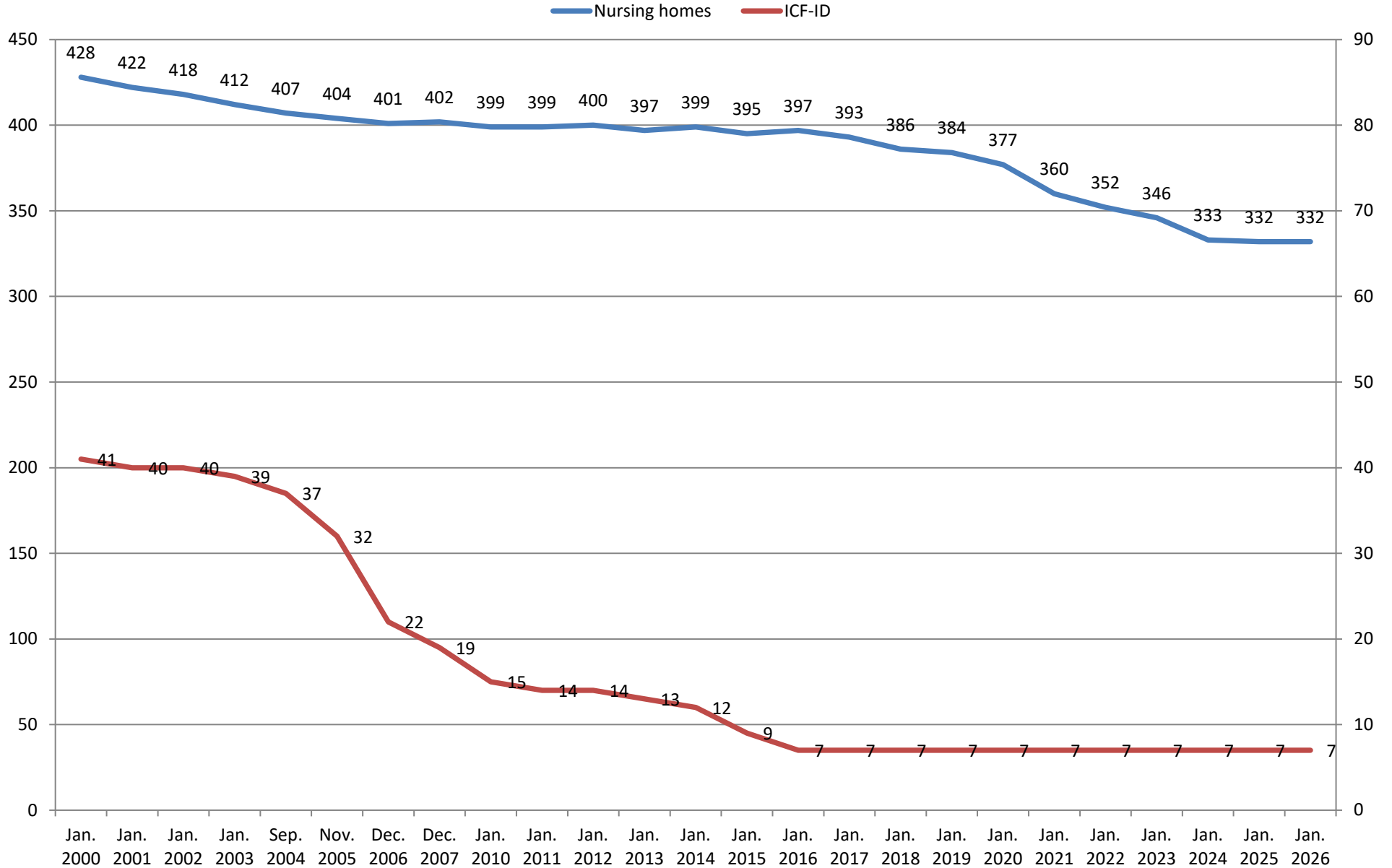

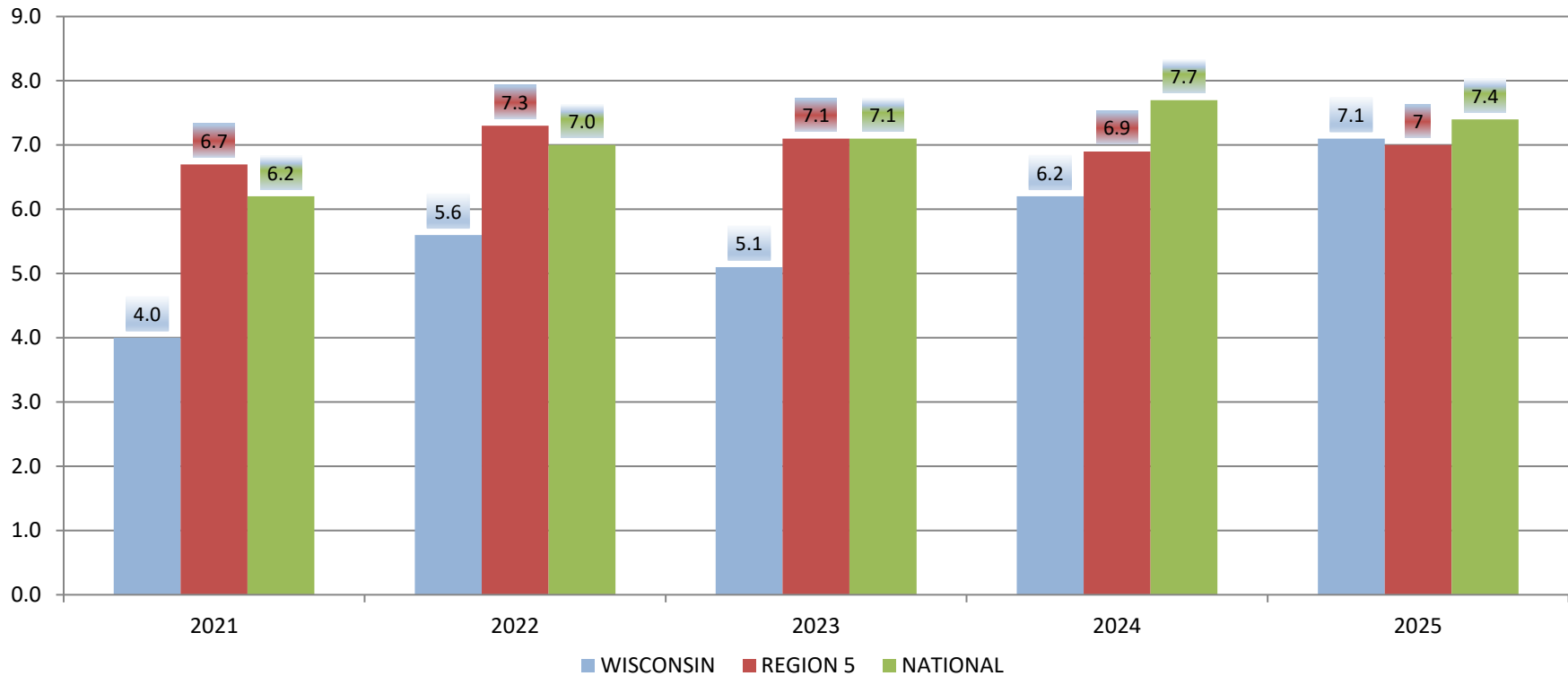
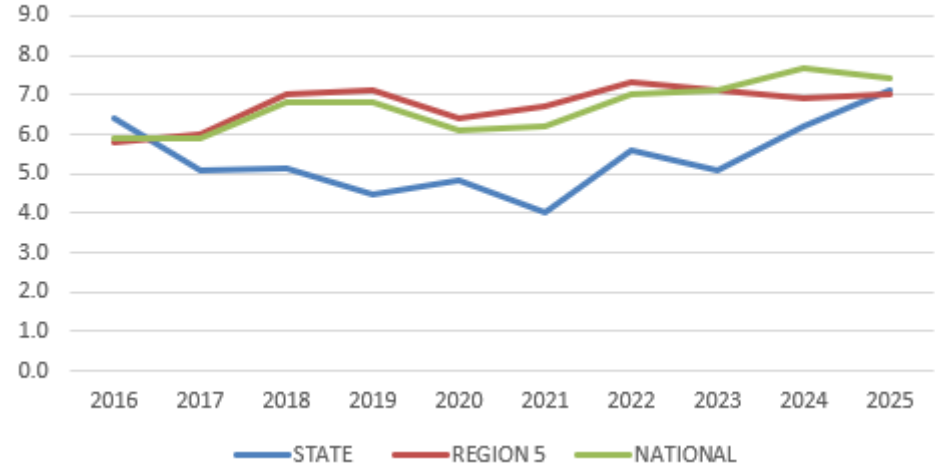
Number of Nursing Homes and Intermediate Care Facilities for the Intellectually Disabled



Average Number of Federal Health Citations per Recertification Survey

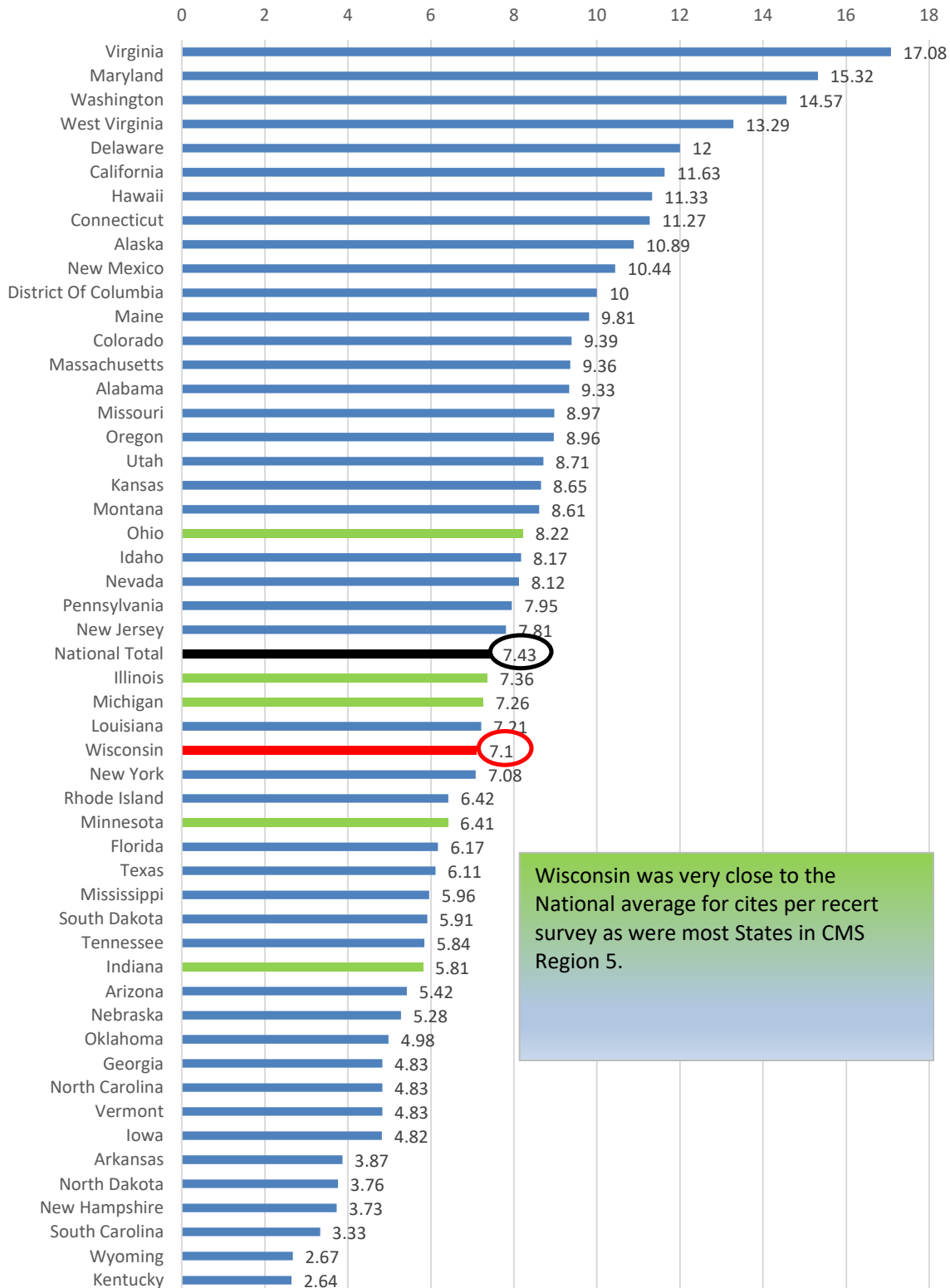

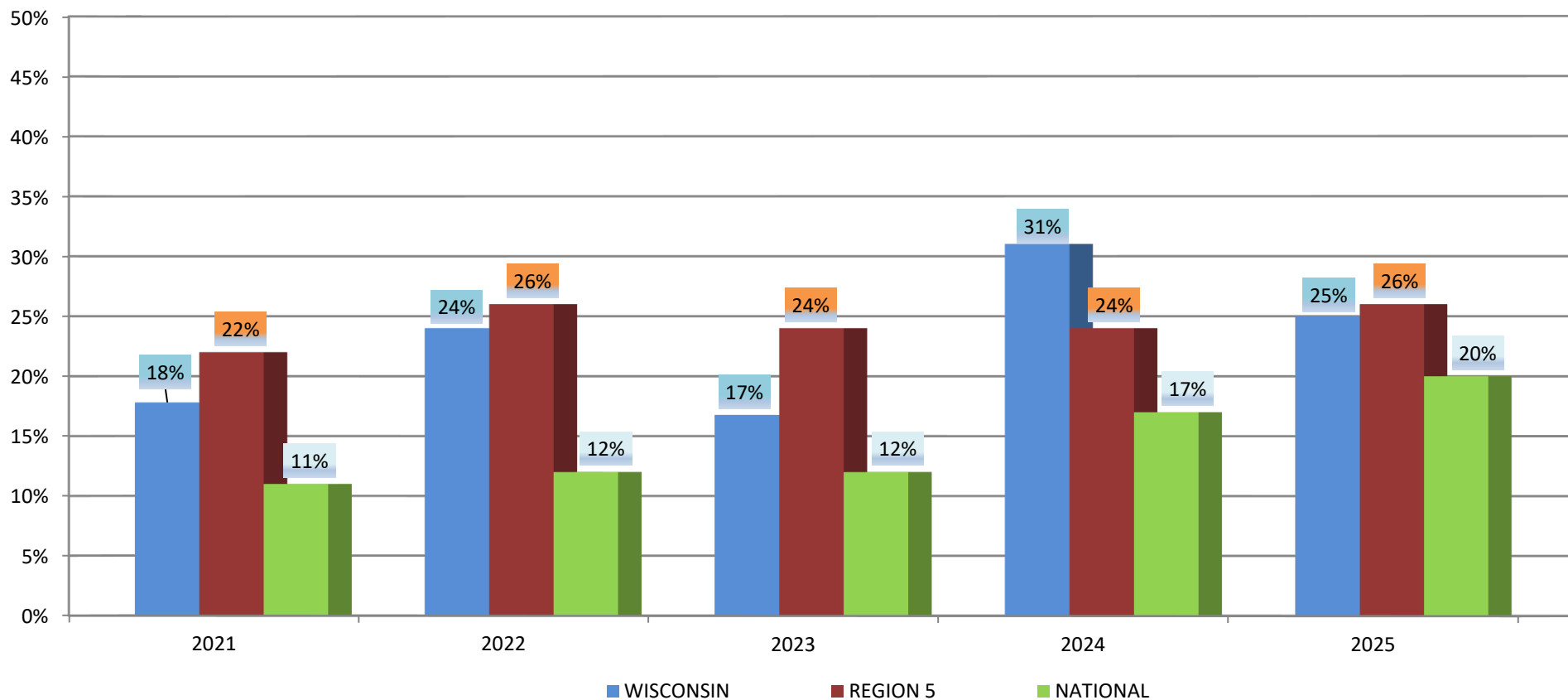
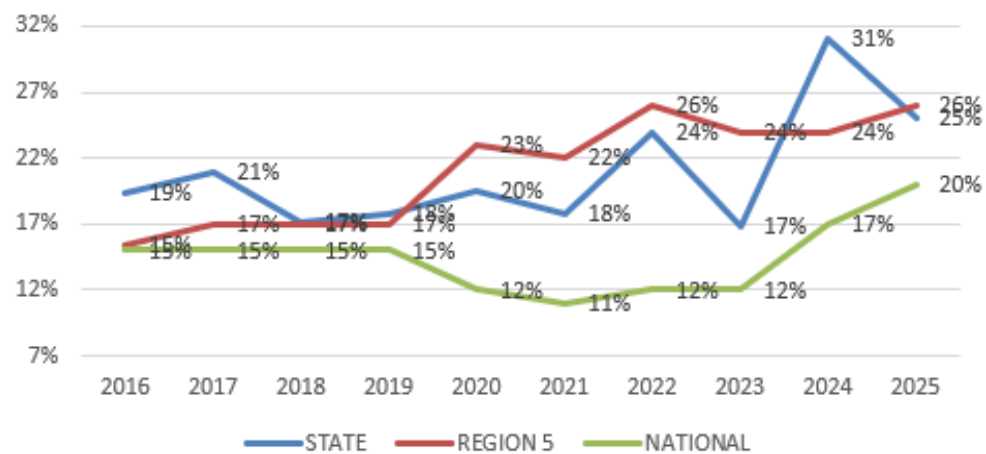




Percentage of Recertification Surveys with Harm or Immediate Jeopardy

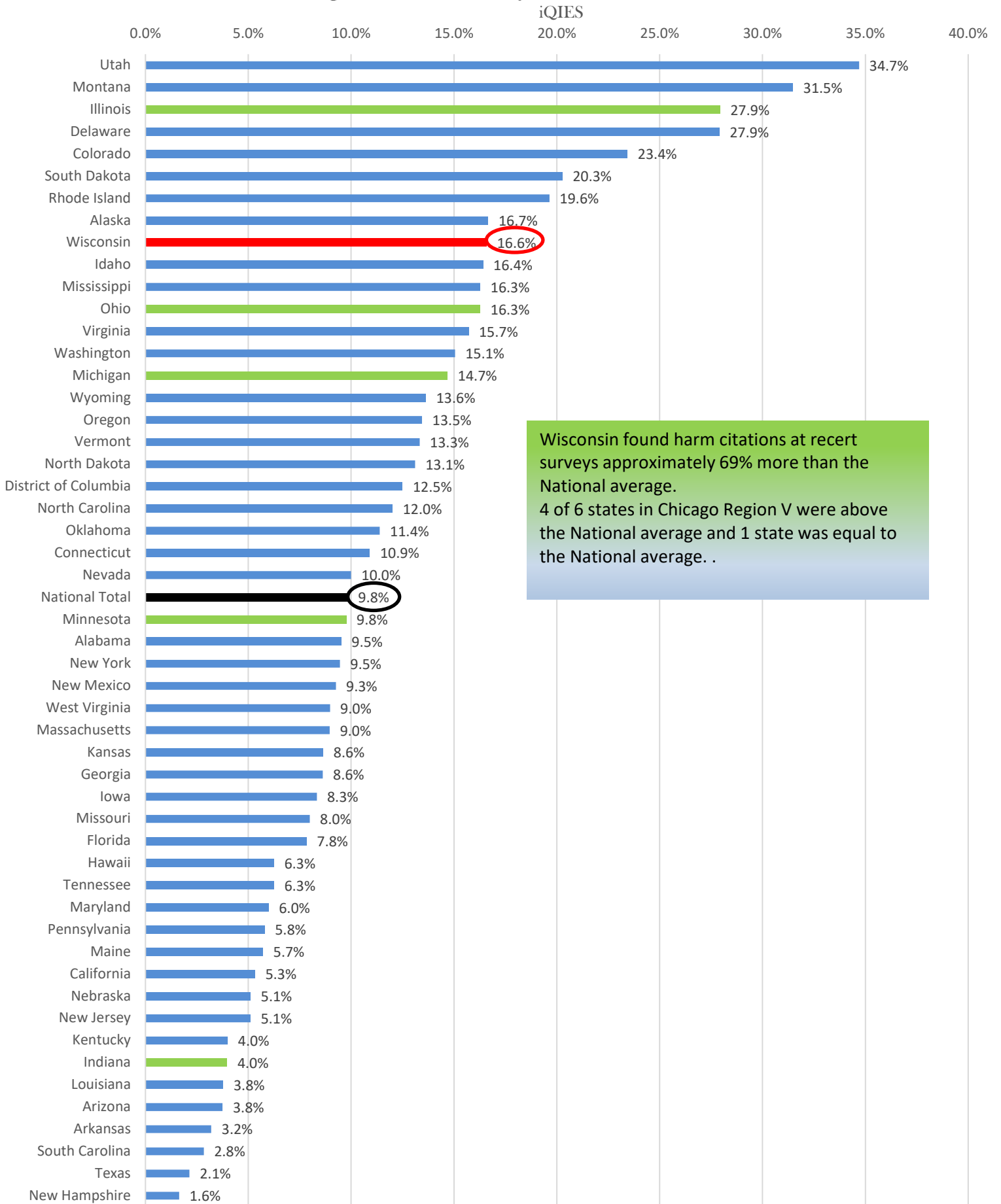

State, Region 5, and US Ten-Year Trend





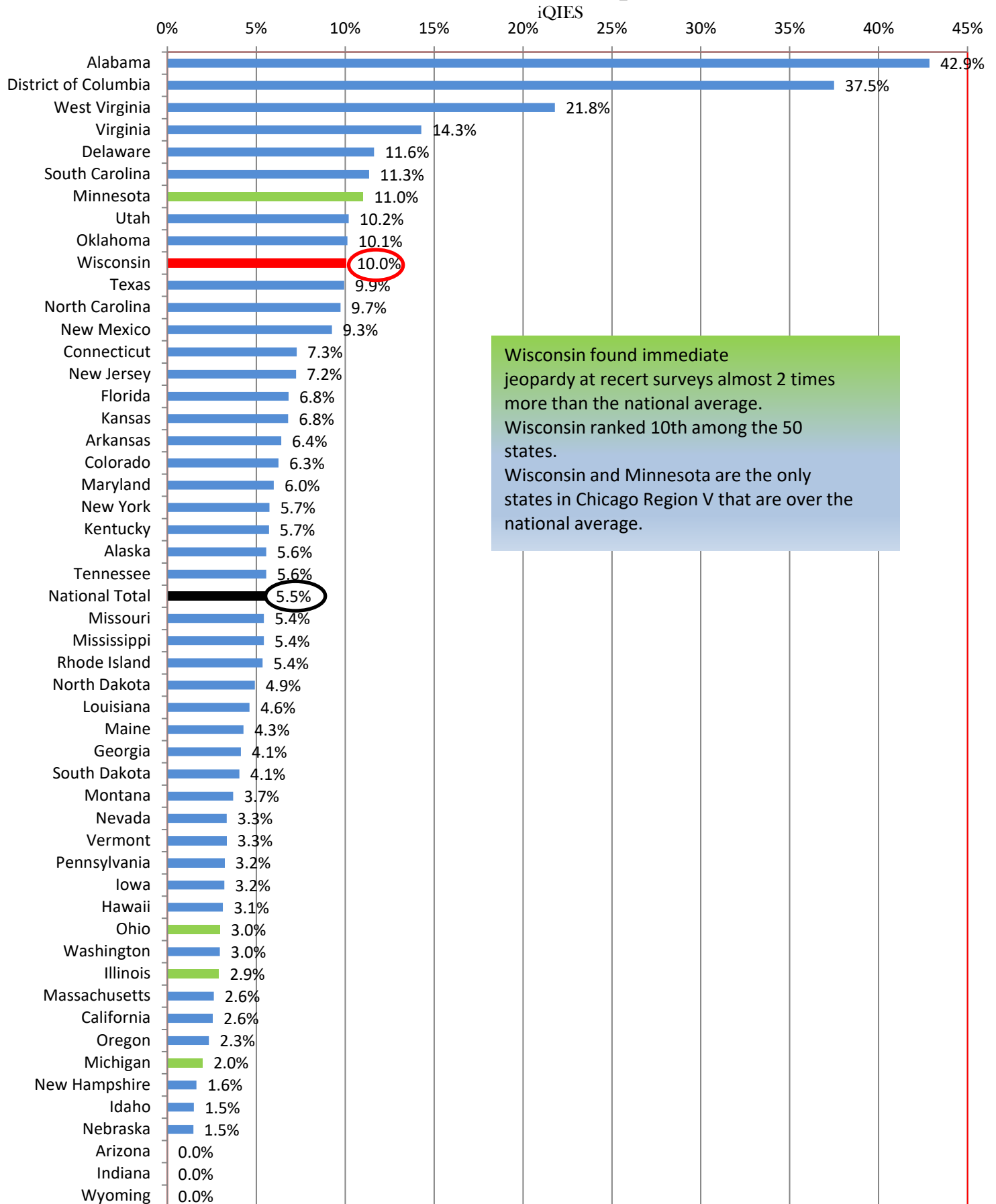
Percentage of Recert Surveys with Actual Harm Citations 2025



Wisconsin found harm citations at recert surveys approximately 69% more than the National average.
 4 of 6 states in Chicago Region V were above the National average and 1 state was equal to the National average.



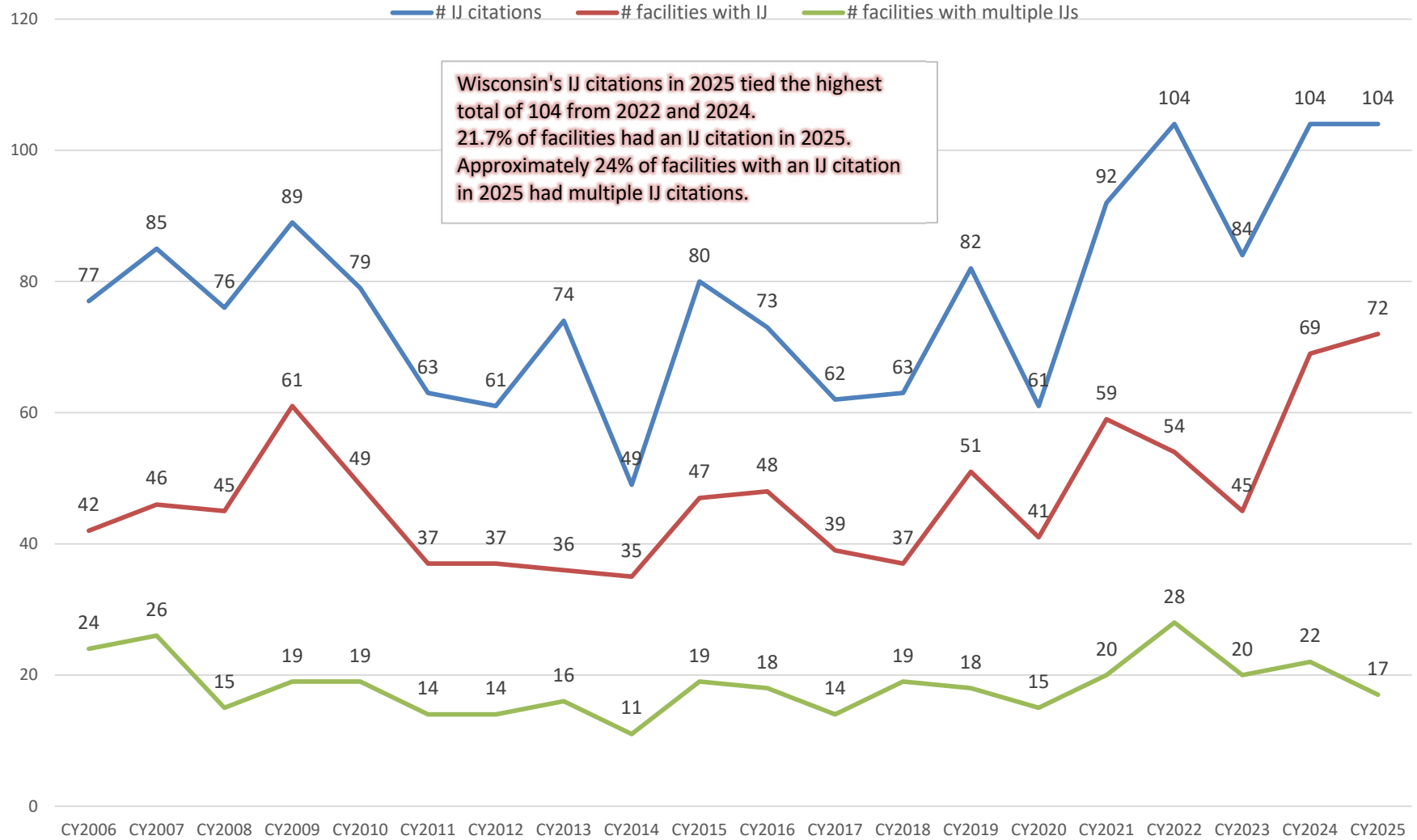
Percentage of 2025 Recertification Surveys with Immediate Jeopardy



Wisconsin found immediate jeopardy at recert surveys almost 2 times more than the national average. Wisconsin ranked 10th among the 50 states. Wisconsin and Minnesota are the only states in Chicago Region V that are over the national average.

Federal Tags Cited at the IJ Level 2022 - 2025

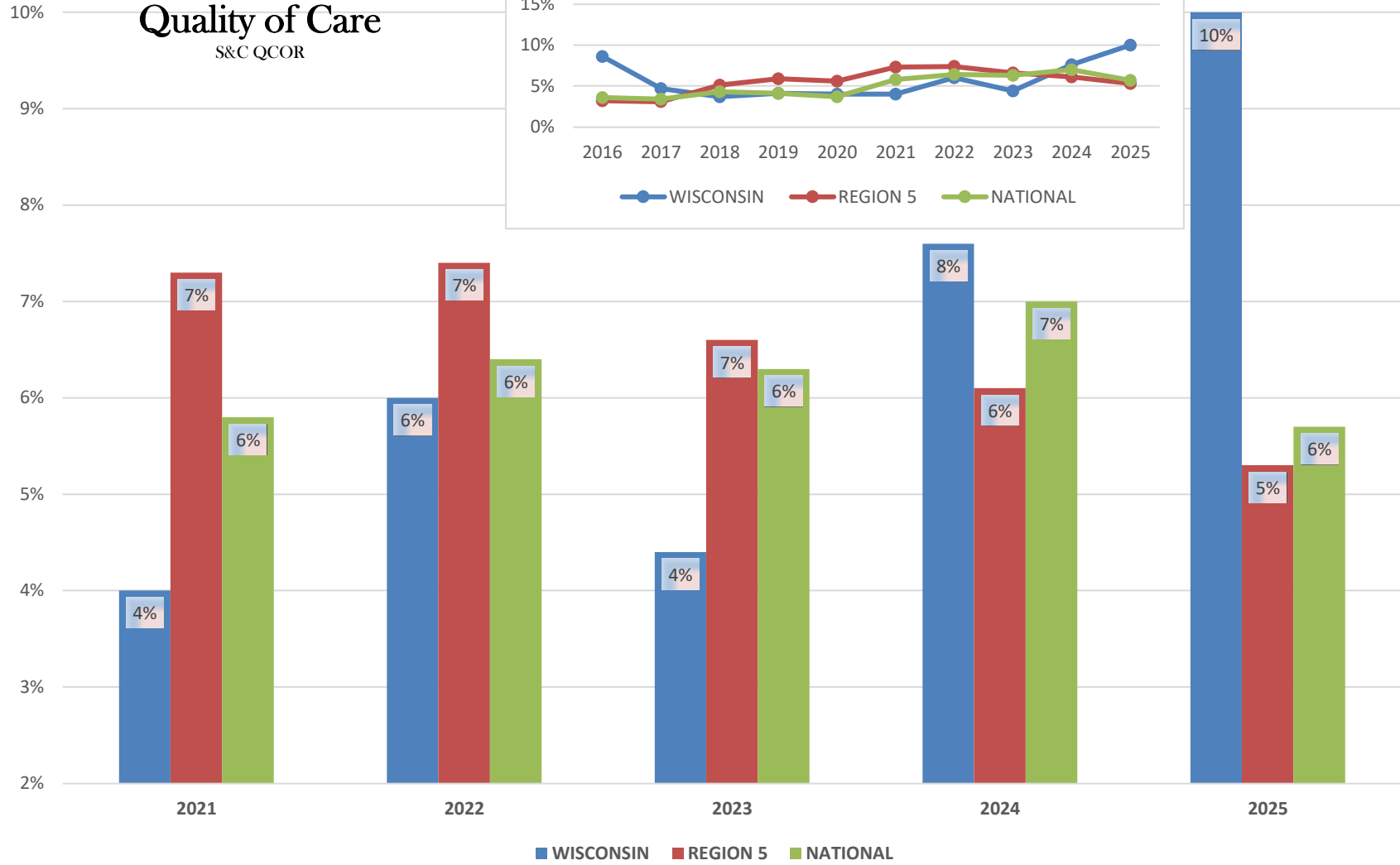
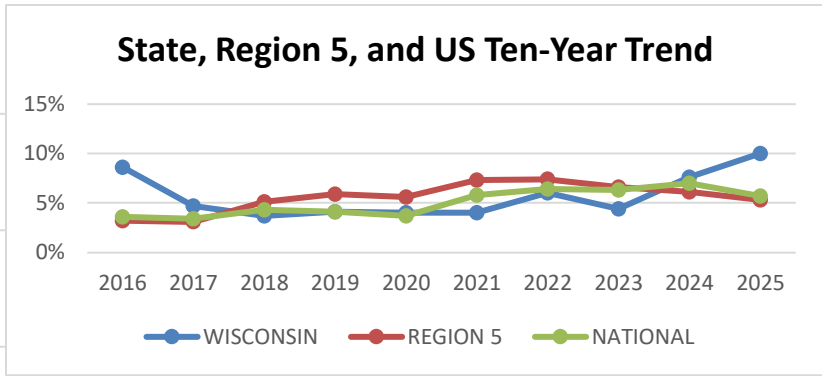

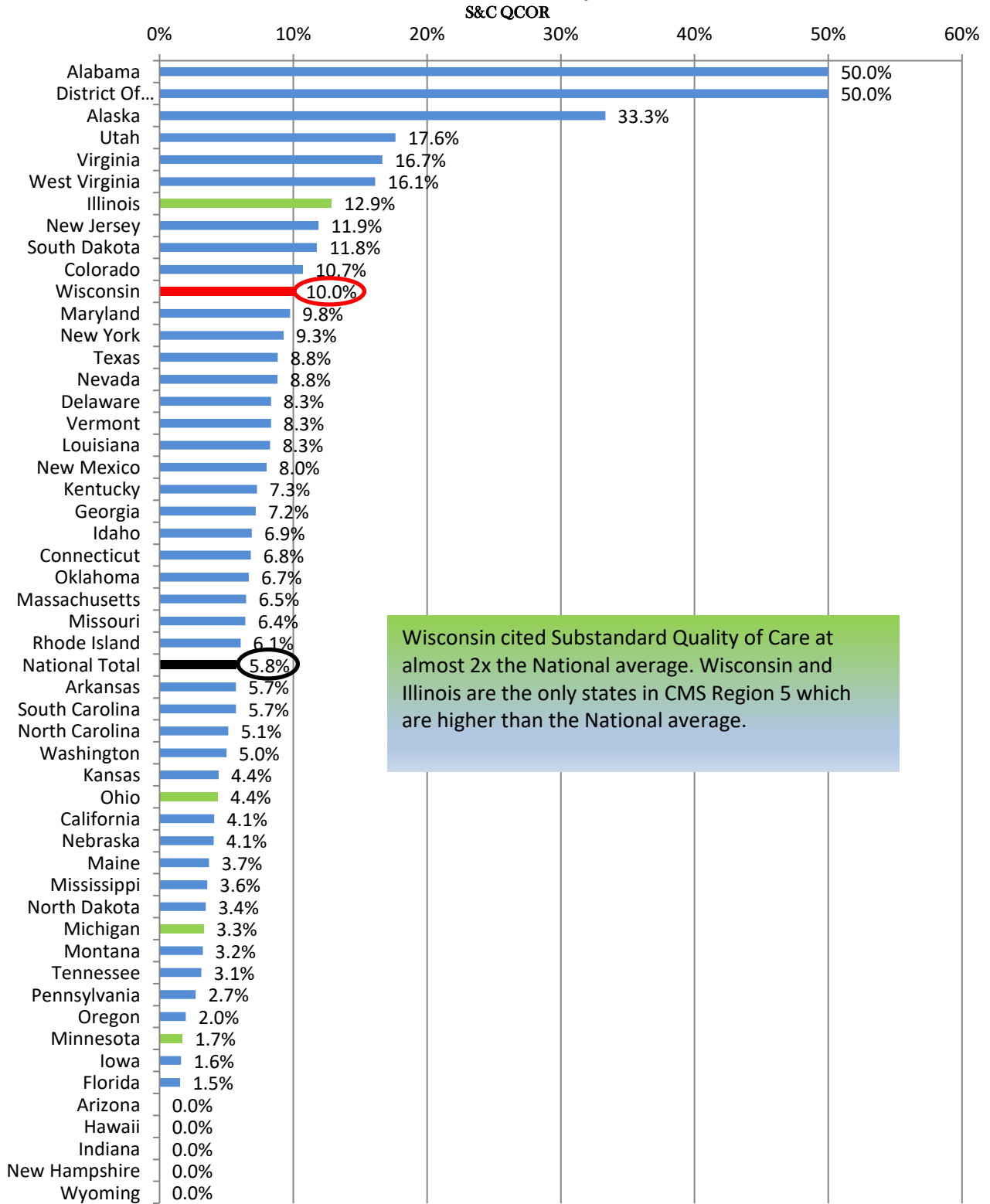

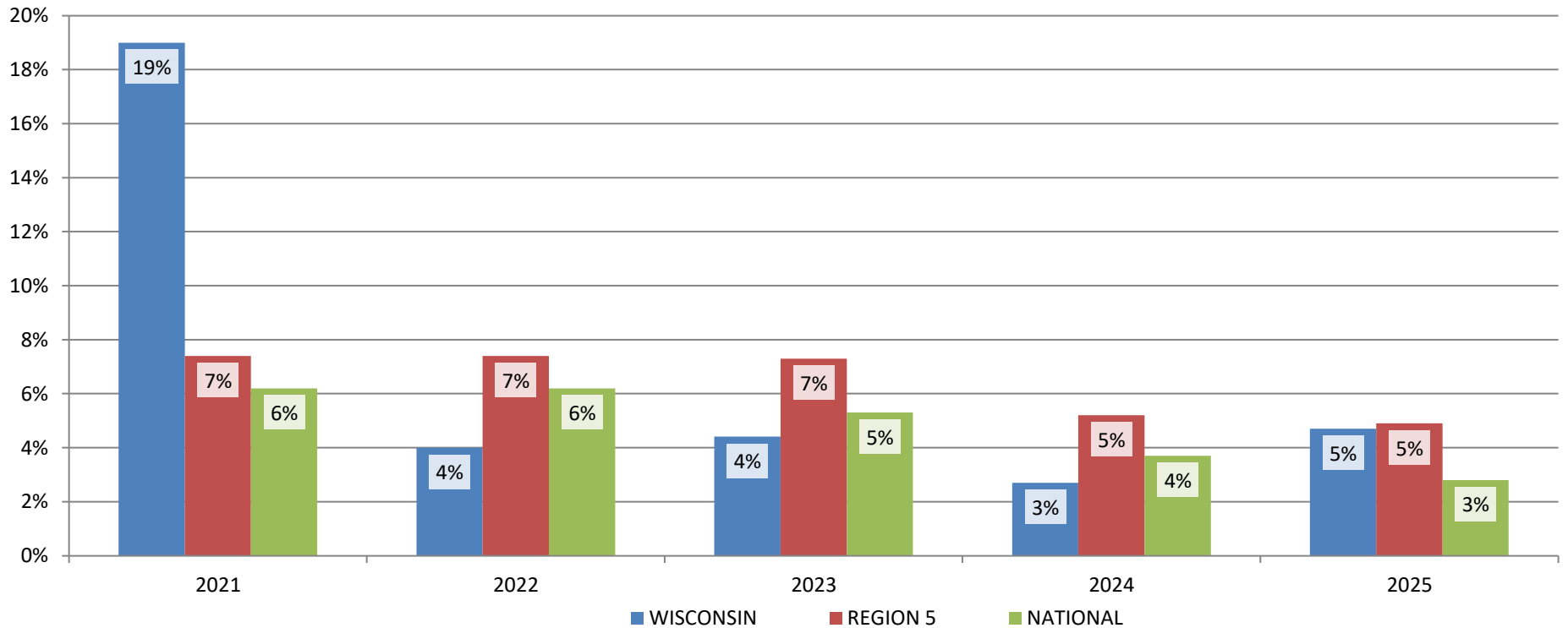
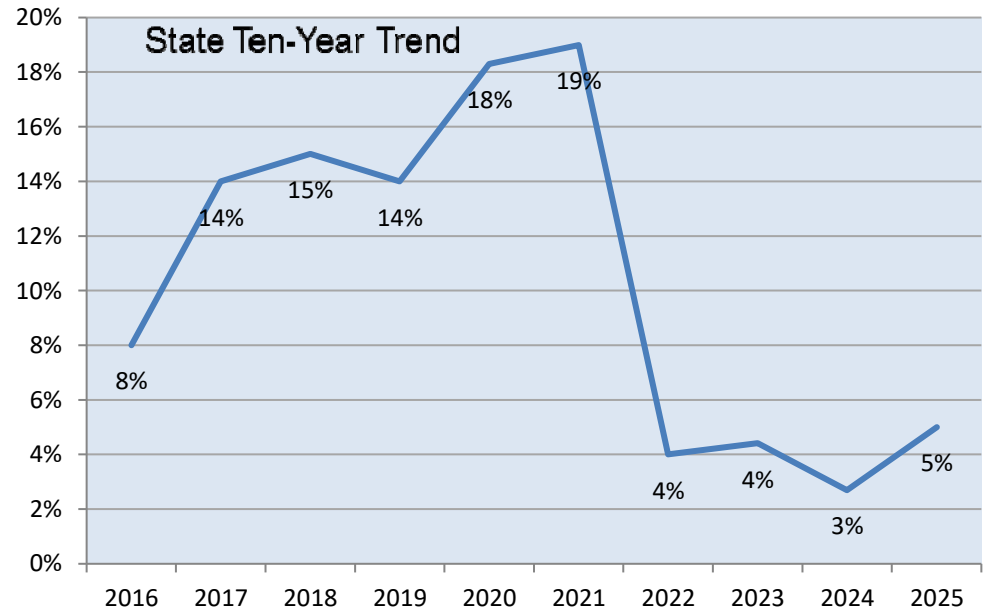
Percentage of 2025 Recertification Surveys with Substandard Quality of Care





Percentage of Deficiency-Free Recertification Surveys (Health)

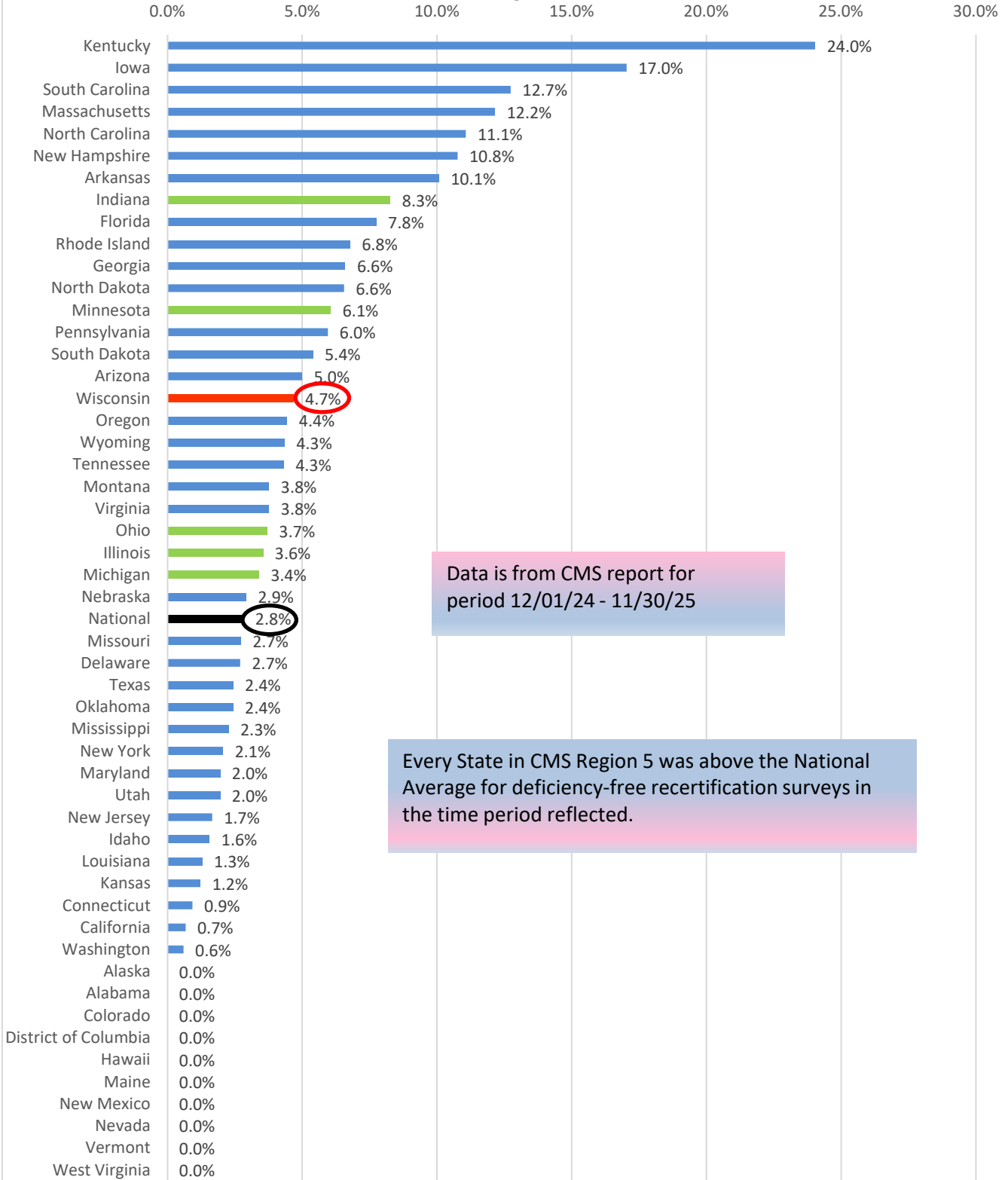

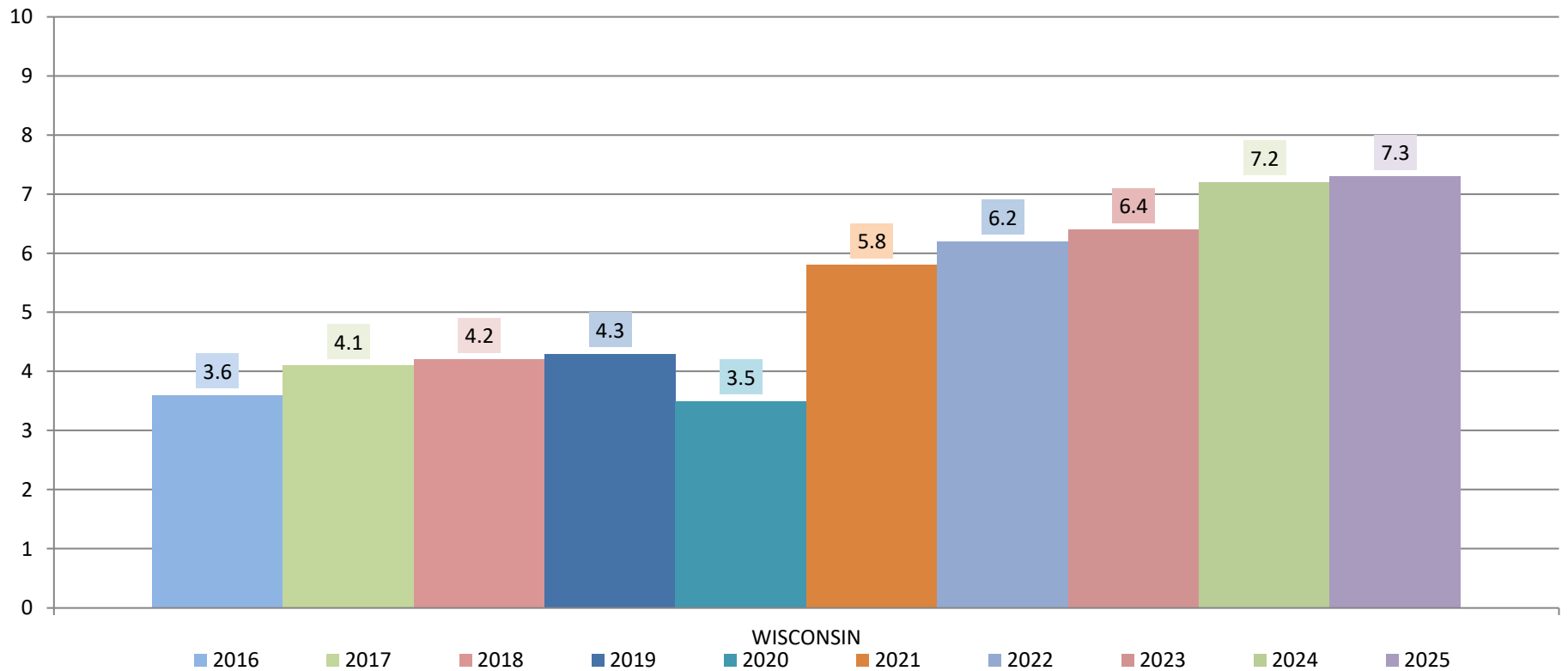
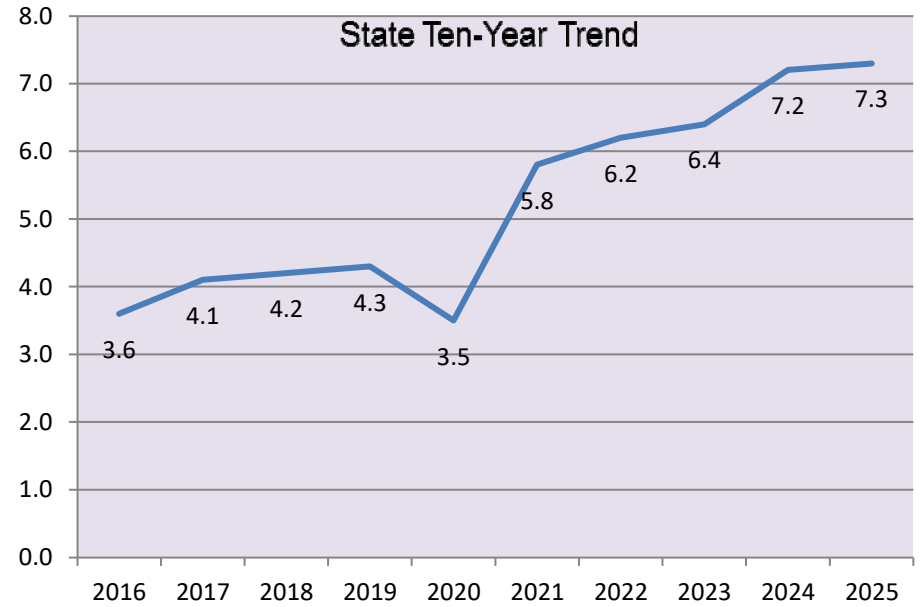

Every State in CMS Region 5 was above the National Average for deficiency-free recertification surveys in the time period reflected.



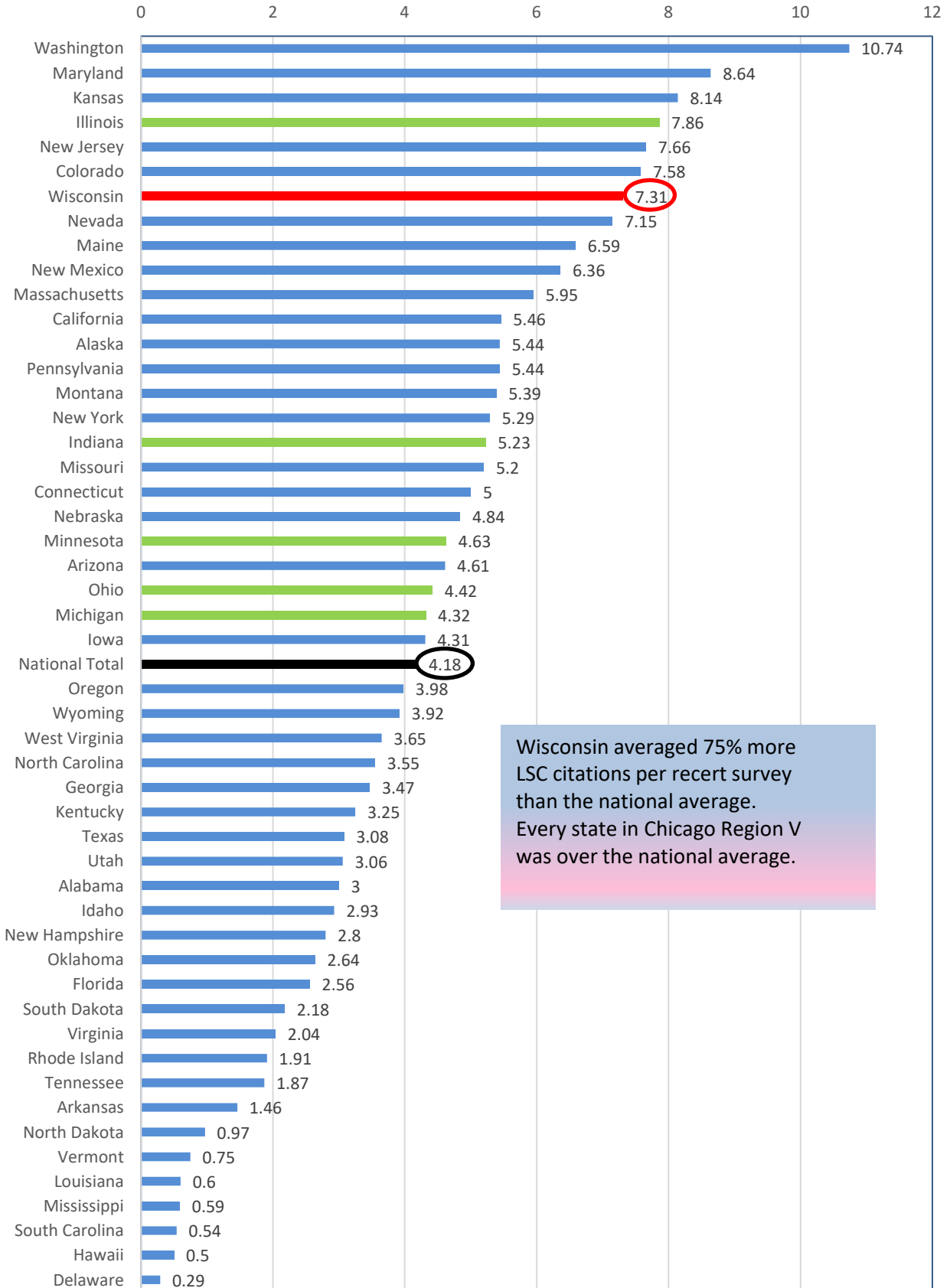
Average Number of Life Safety Code Citations Wisconsin Recertification Surveys 2016-2025 iQIES and S&C QCOR





Average Number Life Safety Code Citations per Recertification Survey 2025

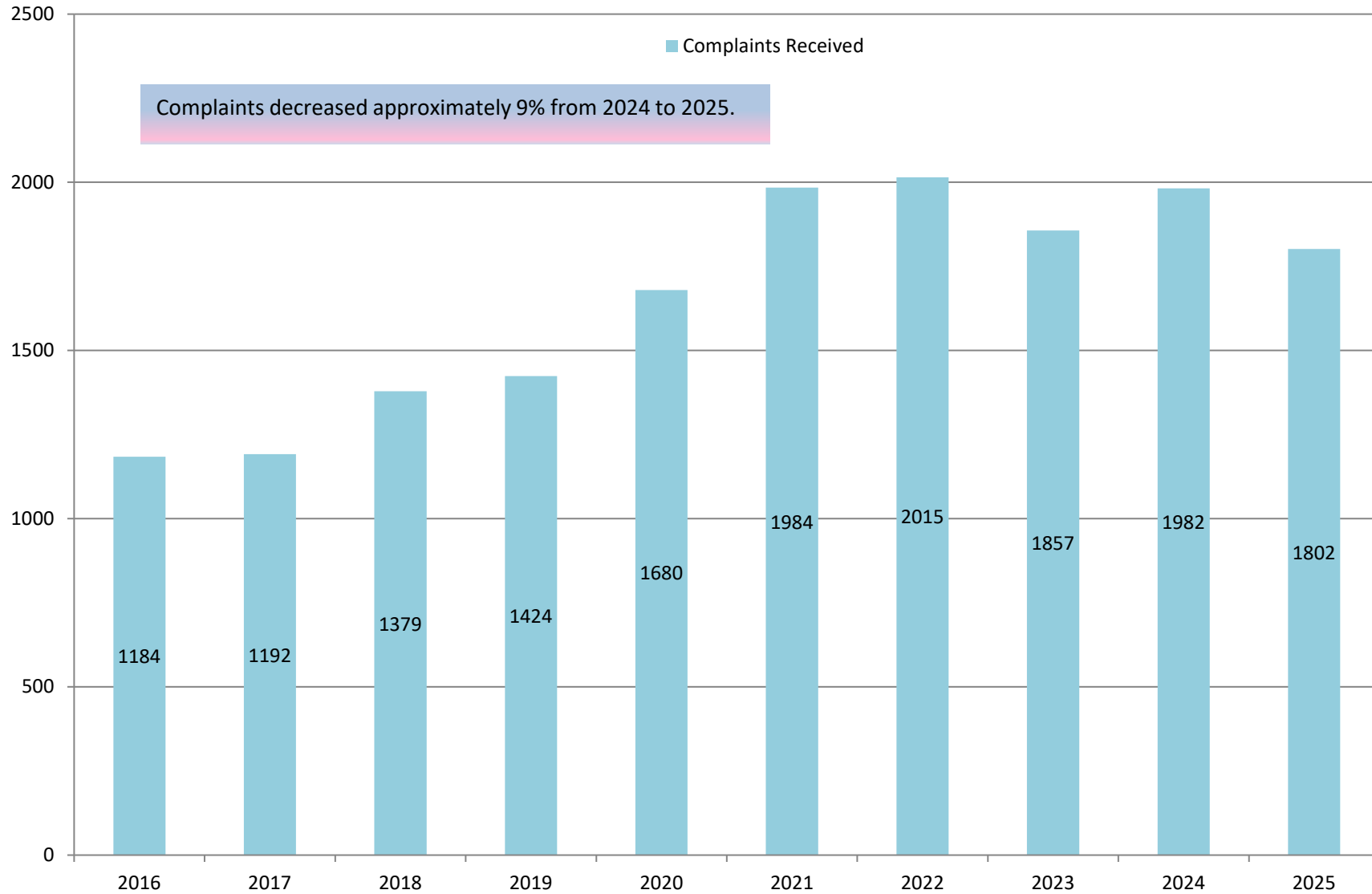

Number of Complaints Received 2016 - 2025

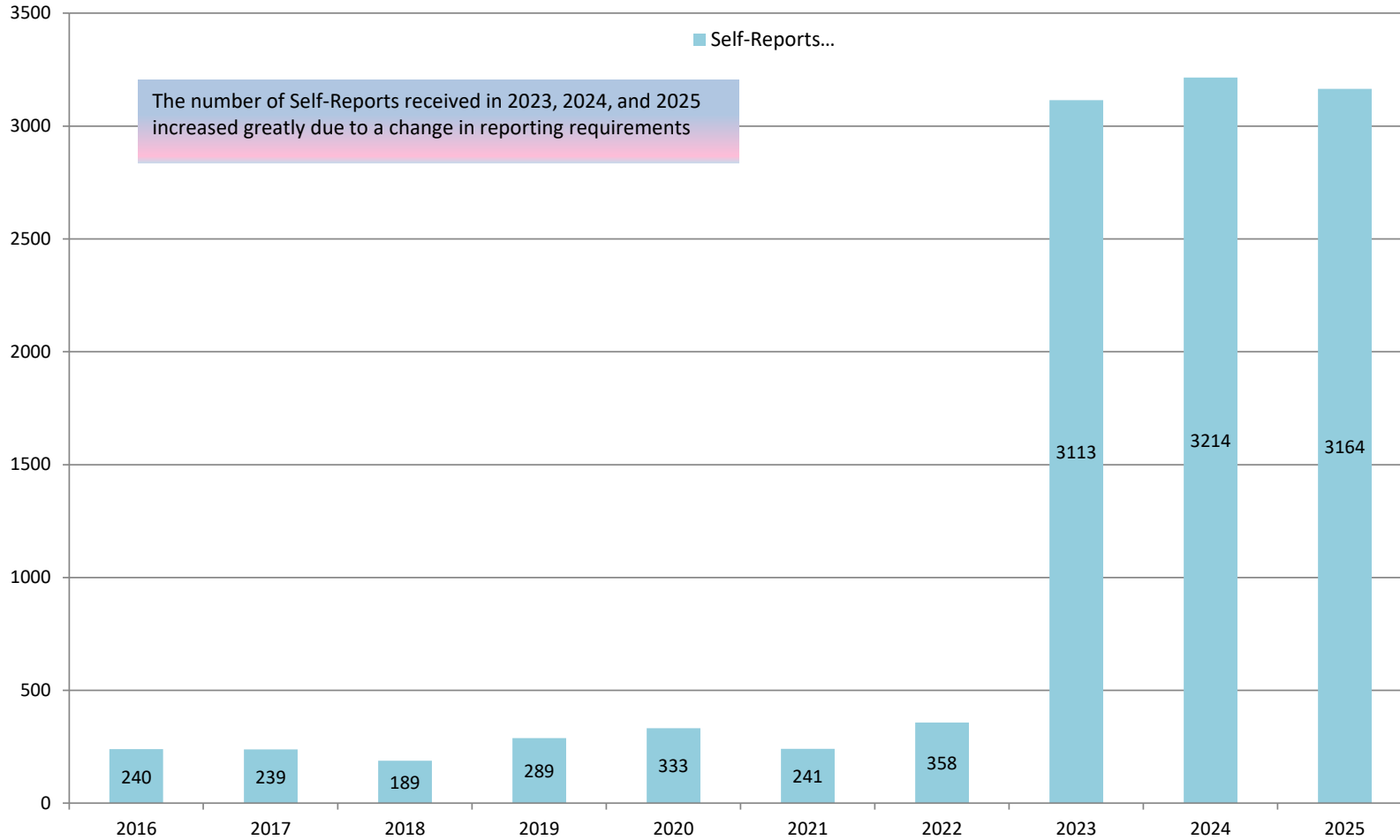

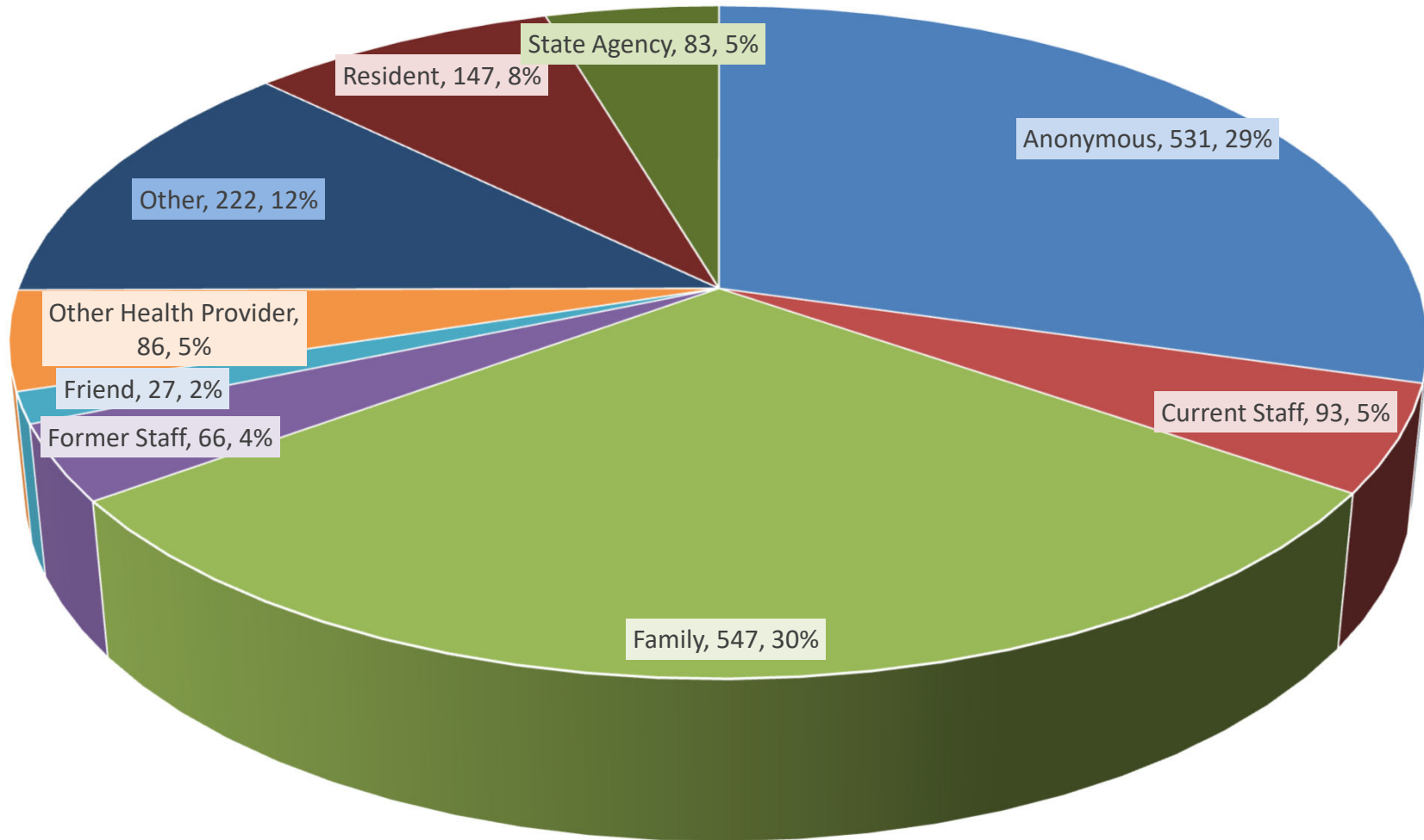
Number of Self-Reports Received 2016 - 2025

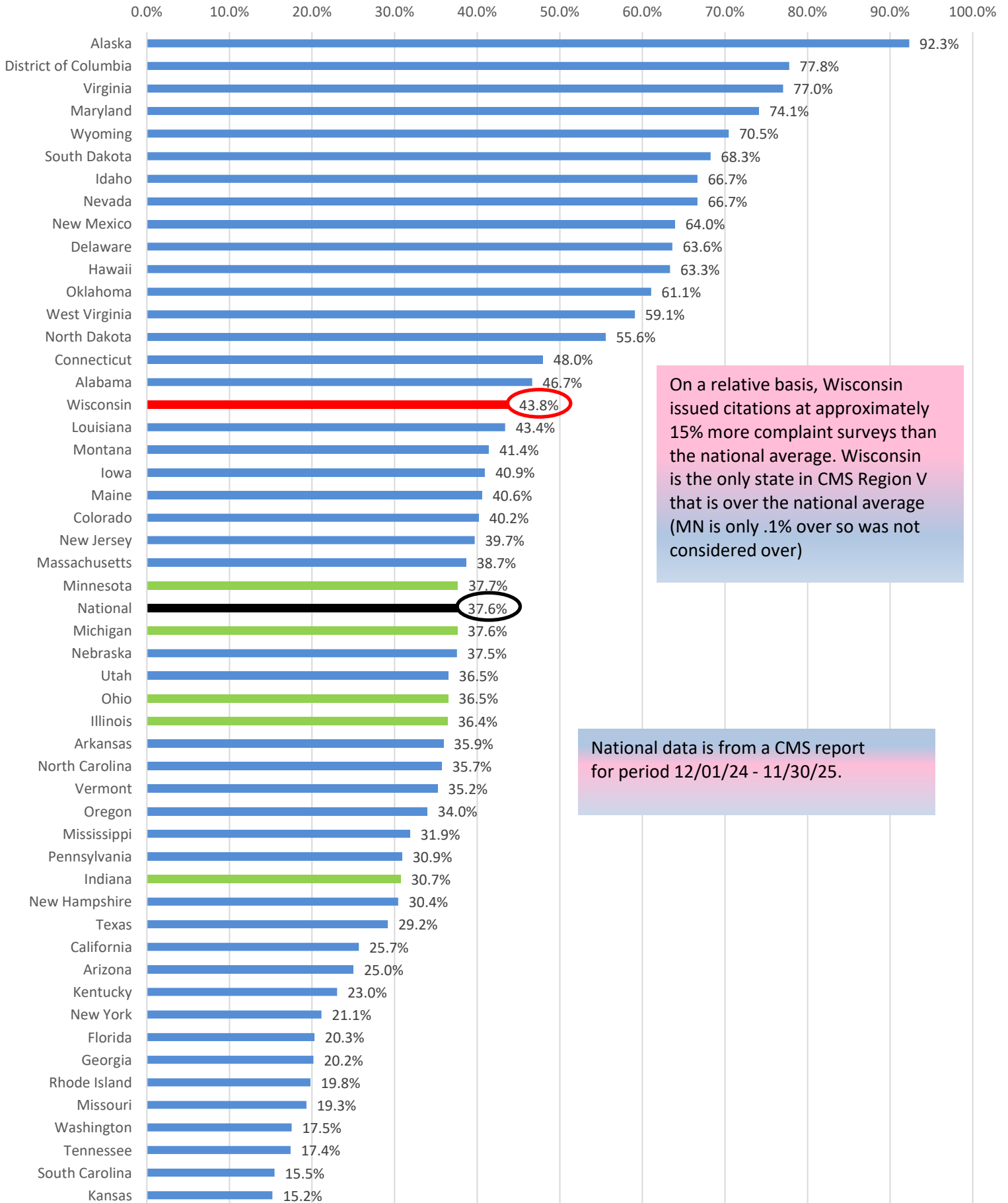
Source of Complaints 2025

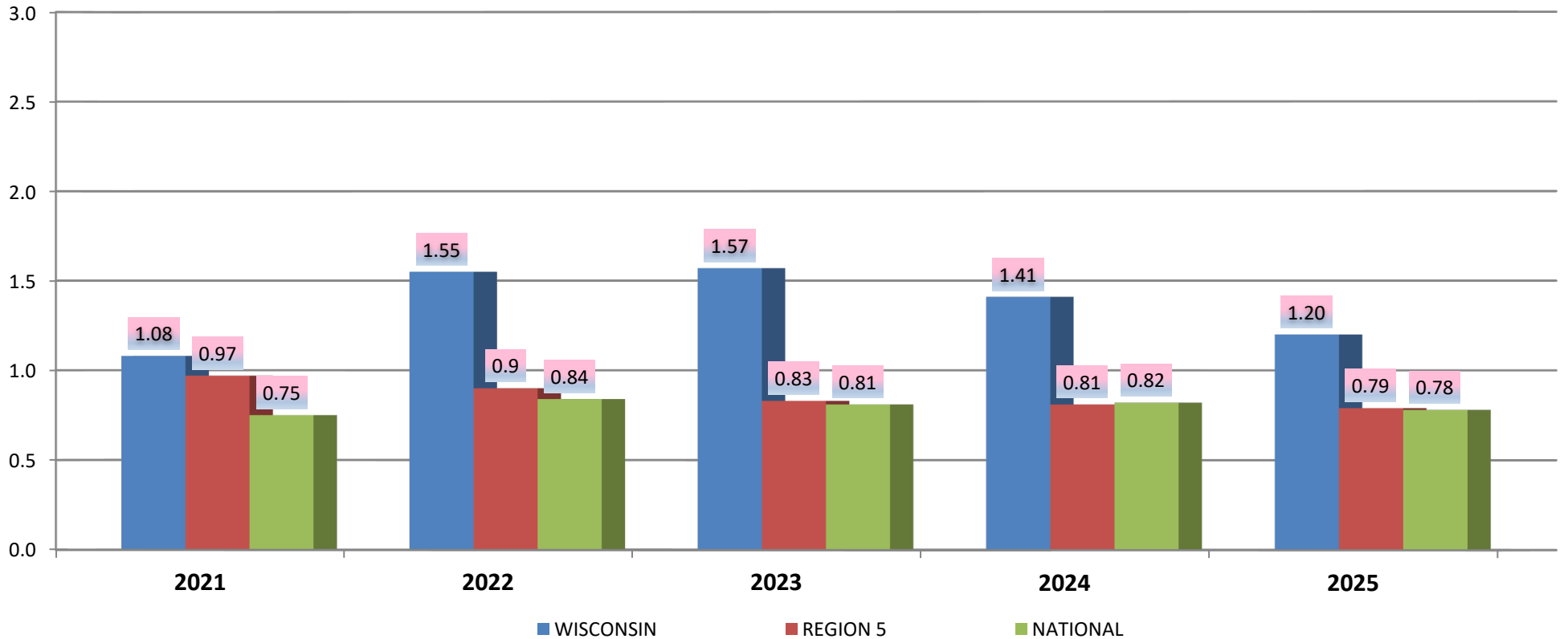
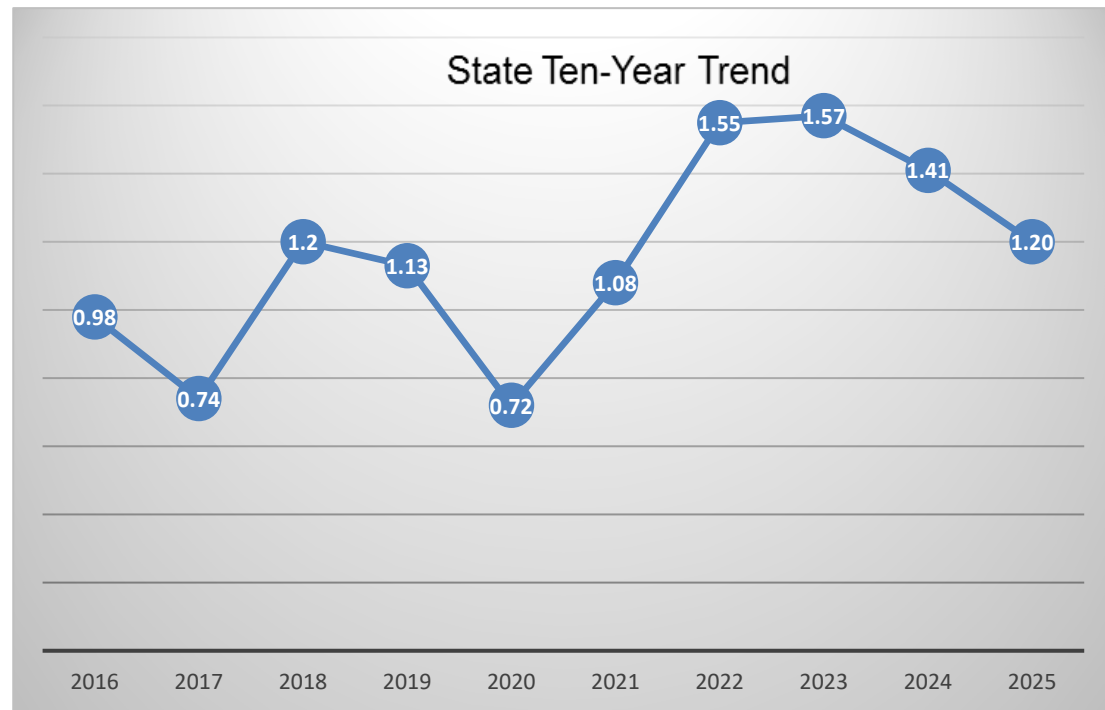

Average Number of Citations per Complaint Survey

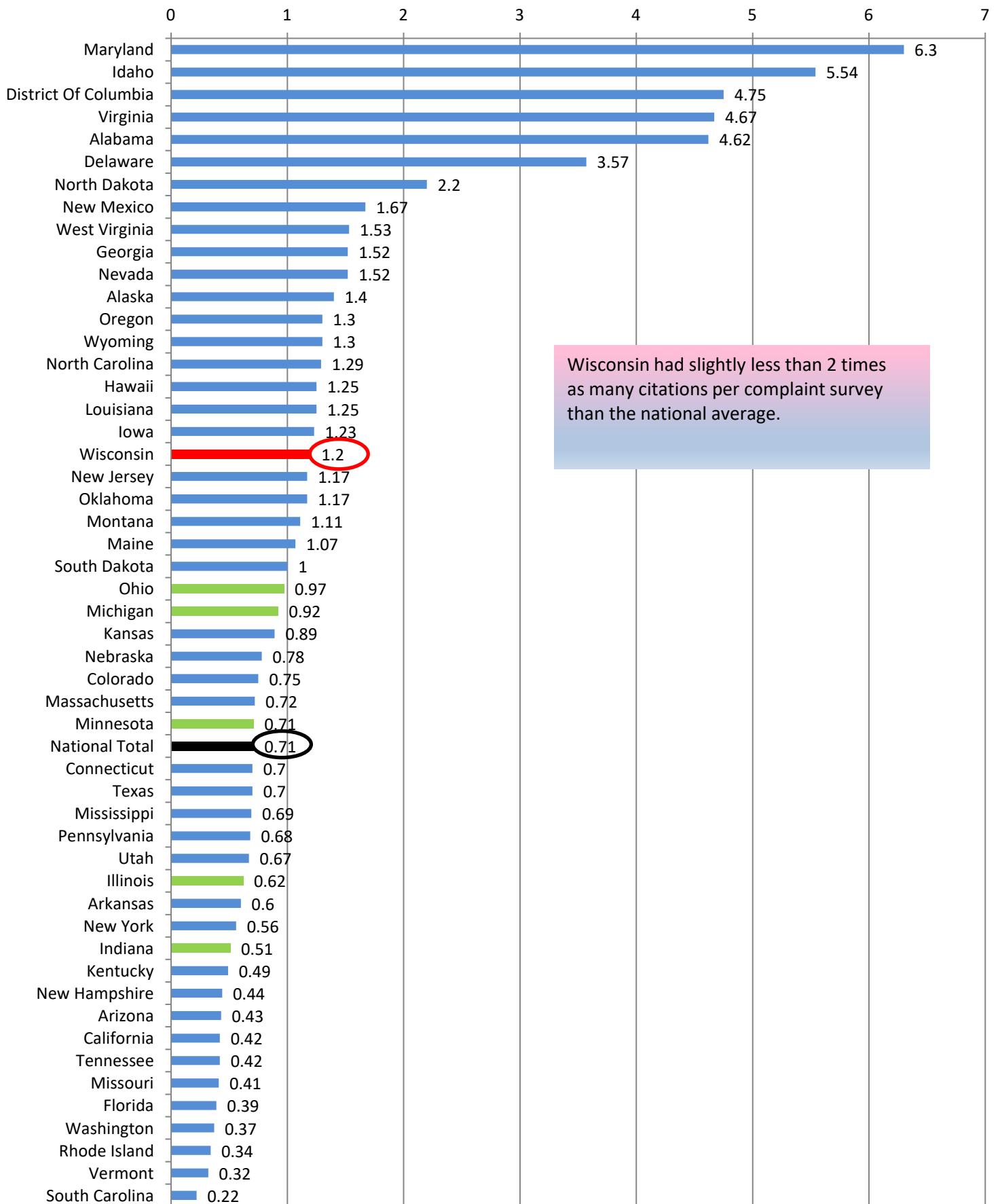

Average Number of Federal Health Citations per Complaint Survey 2025

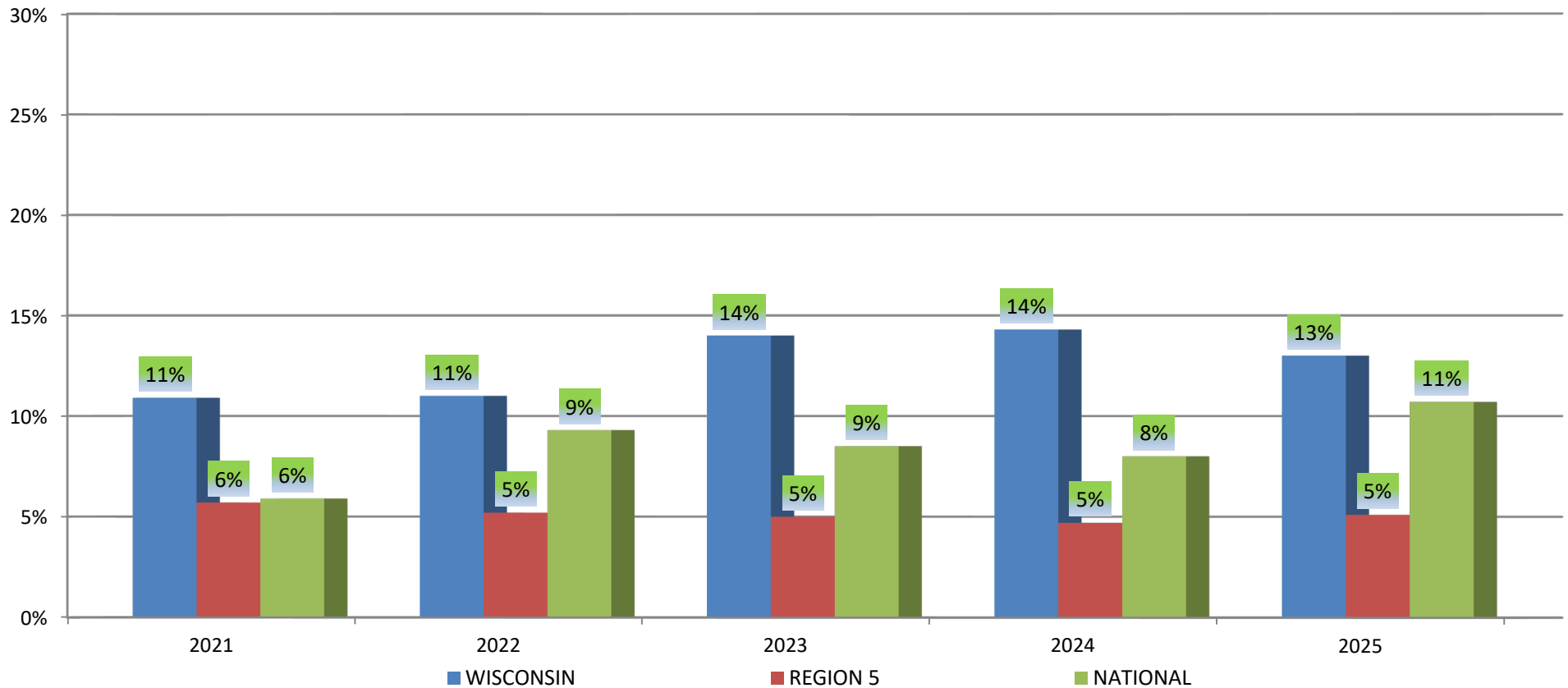
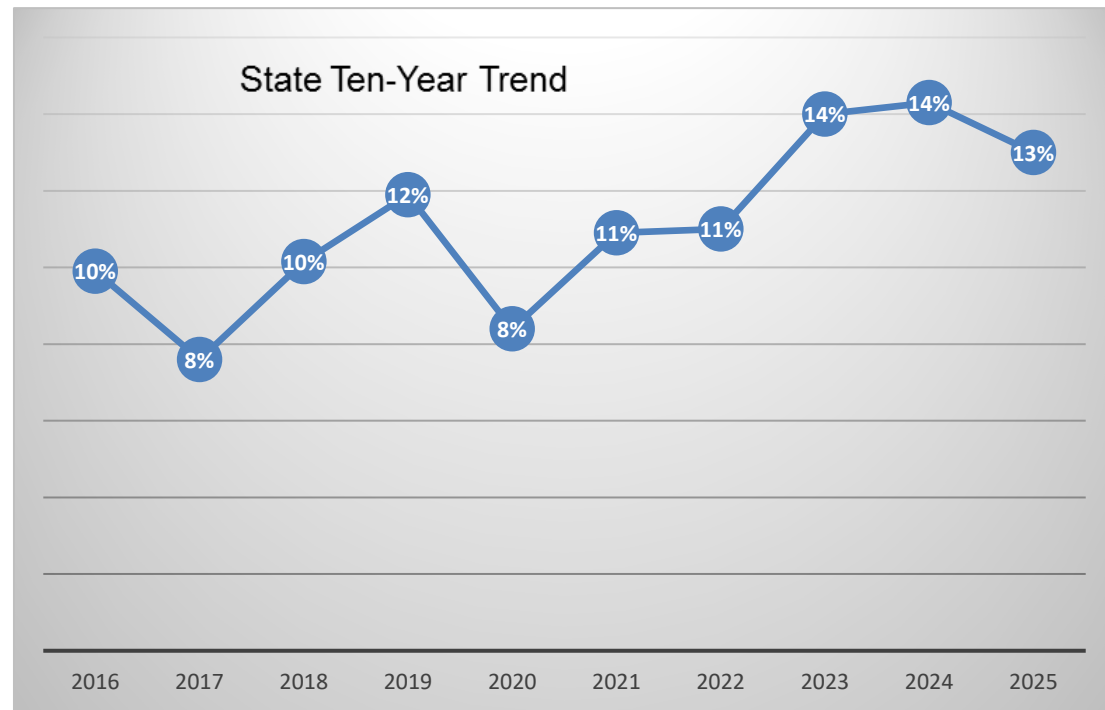

Percentage of Complaint Surveys with Harm or Immediate Jeopardy

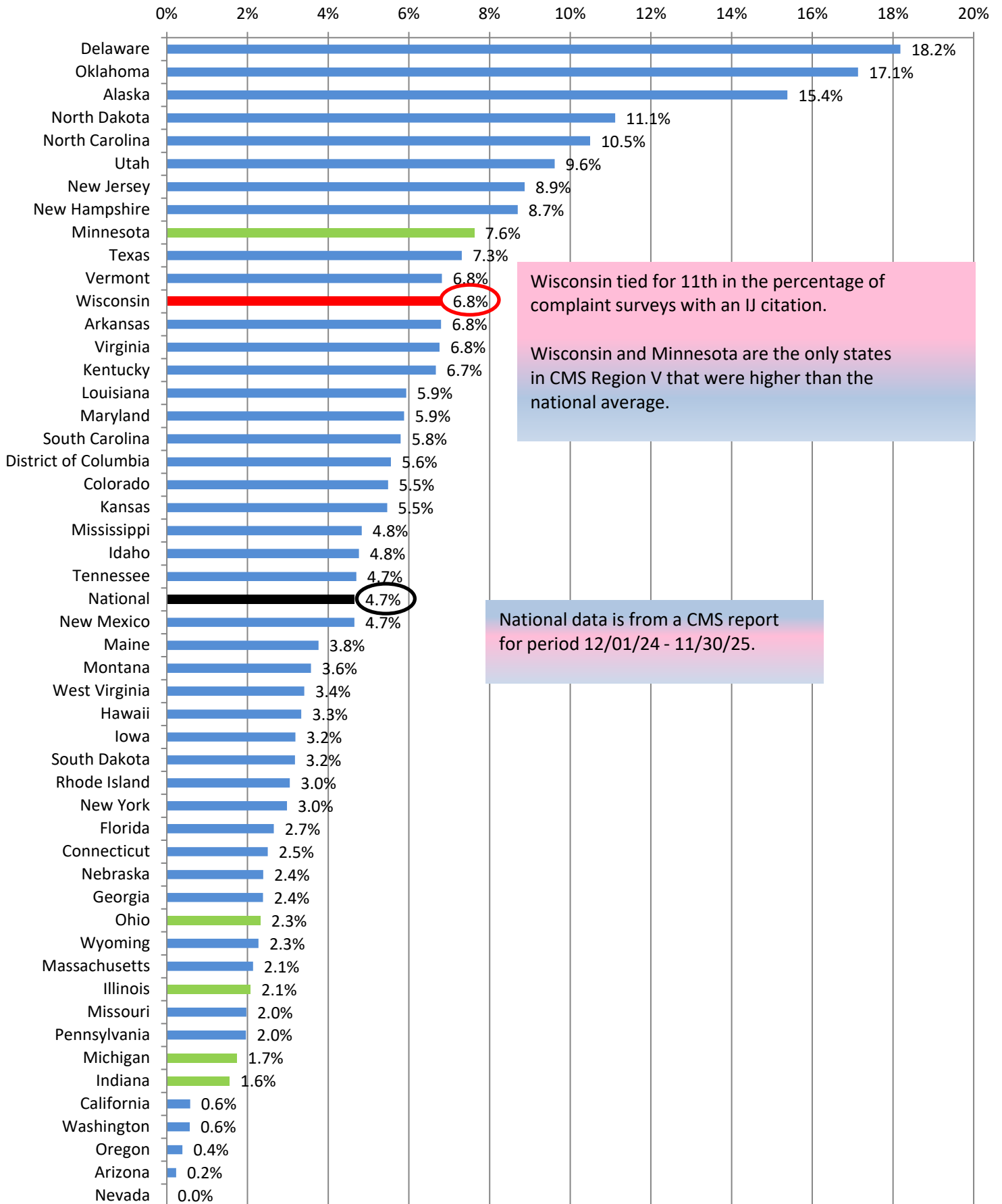

Wisconsin tied for 11th in the percentage of complaint surveys with an IJ citation.

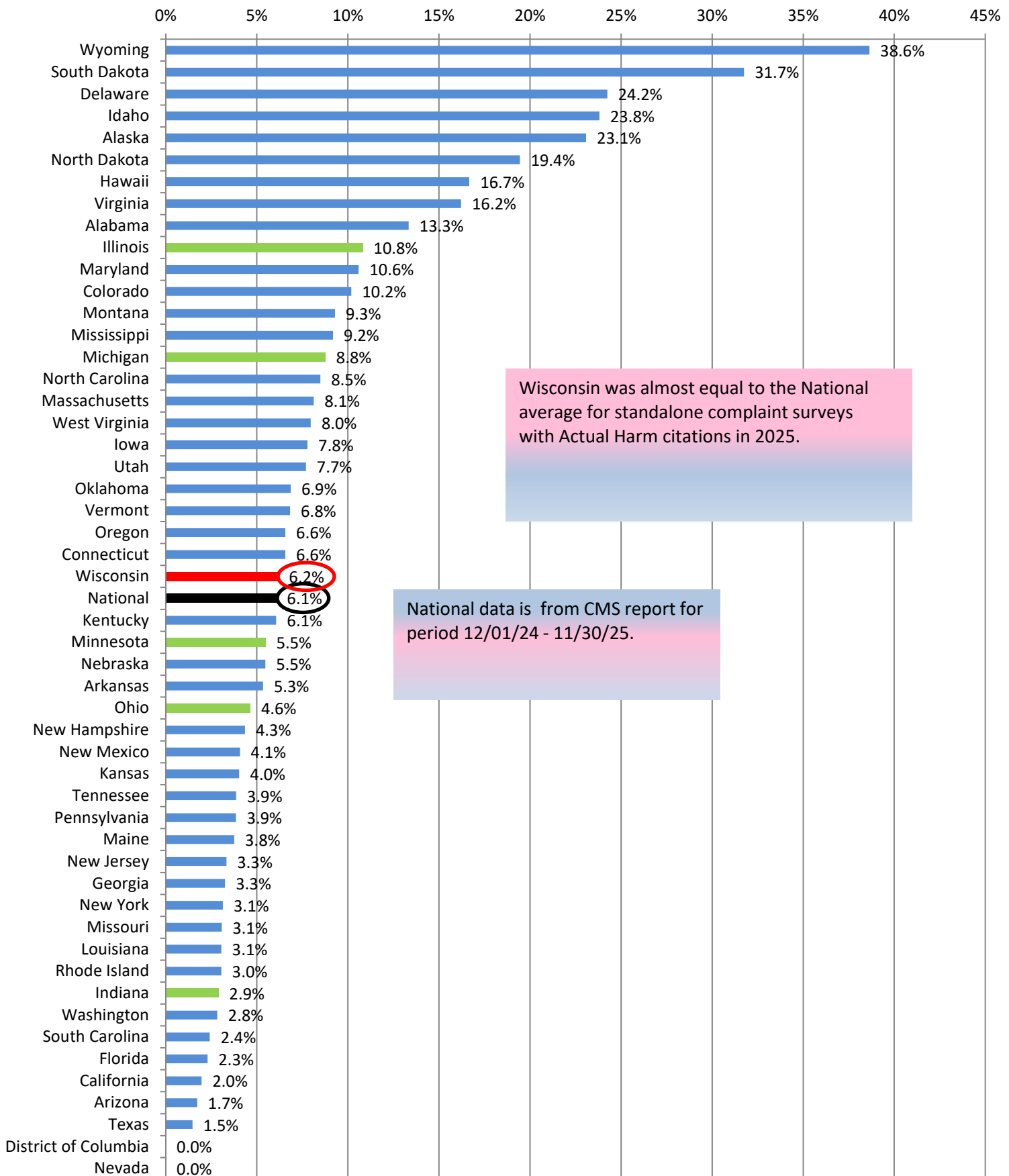
Wisconsin and Minnesota are the only states in CMS Region V that were higher than the national average.

Percentage of Standalone Complaint Surveys with Harm Citations 2025

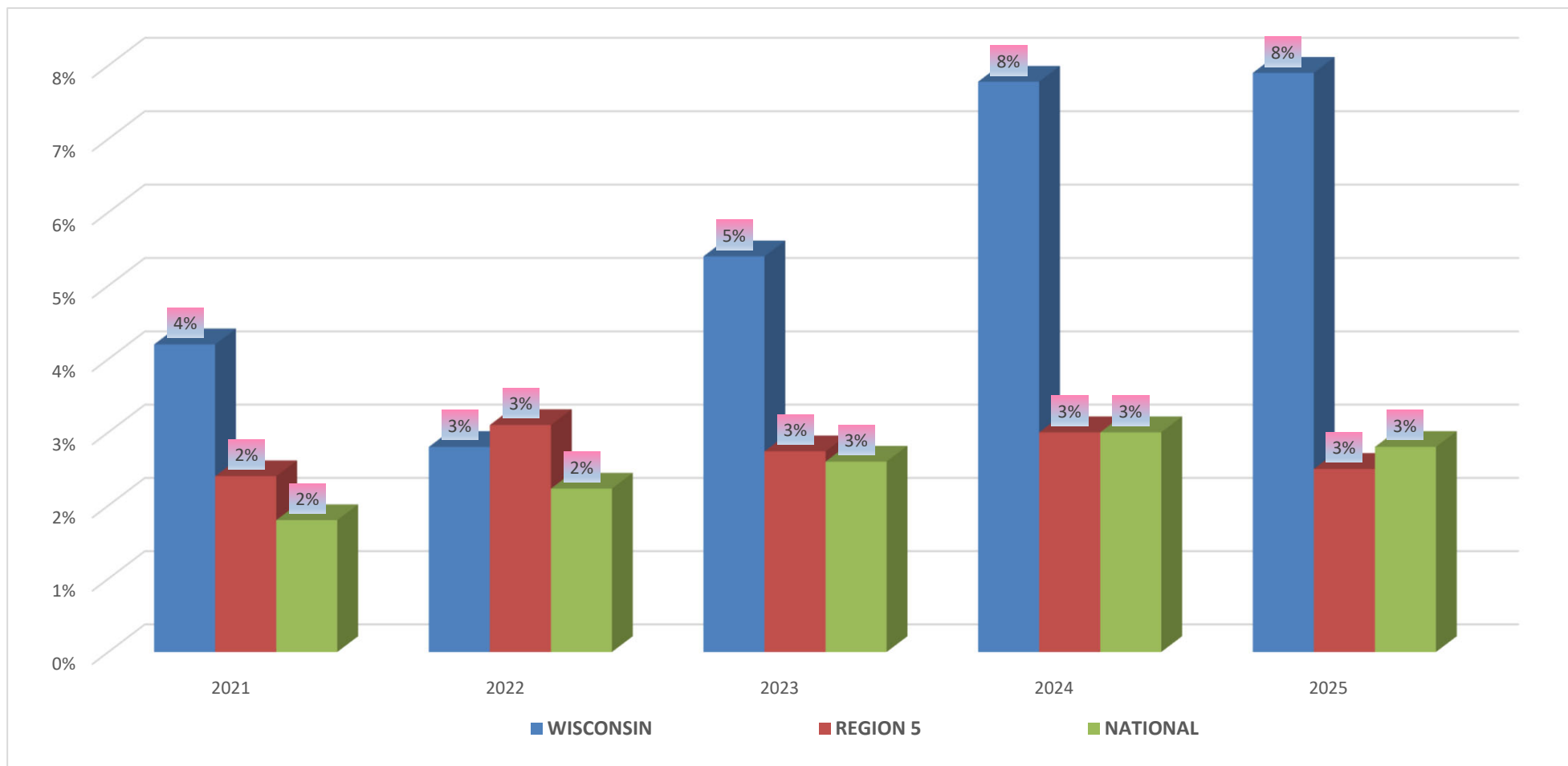
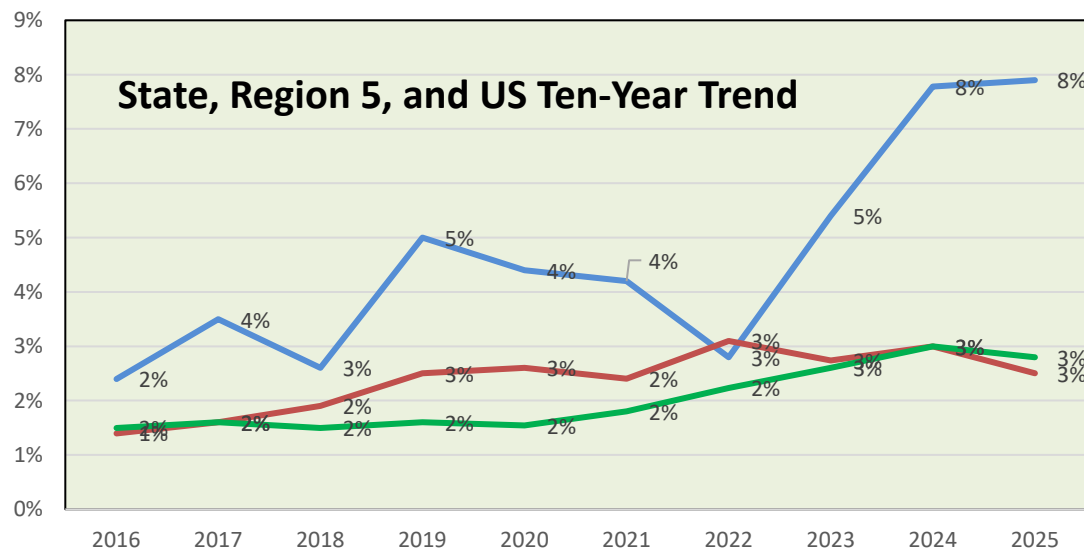

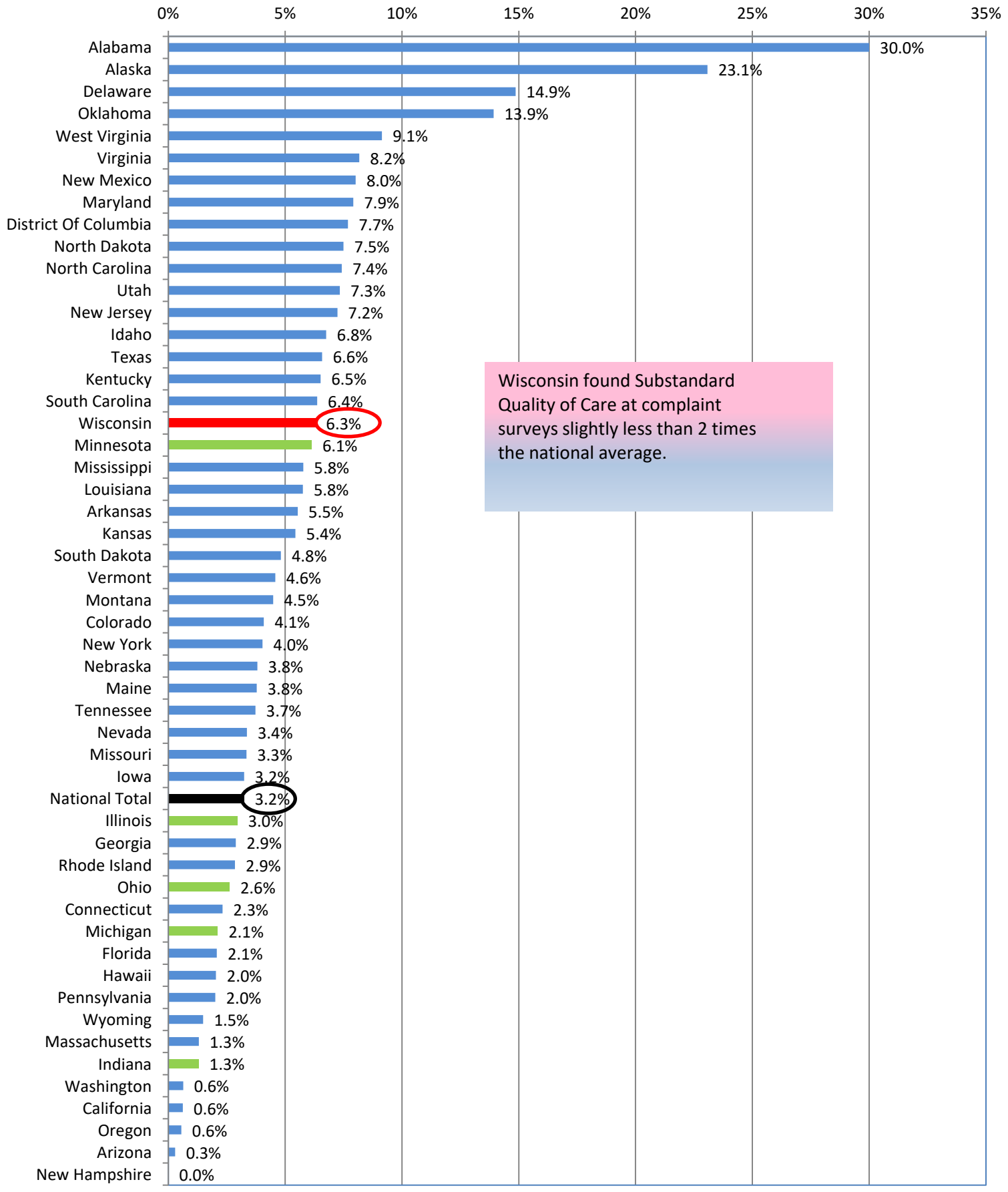
Percent of Complaint Surveys with Substandard Quality of Care

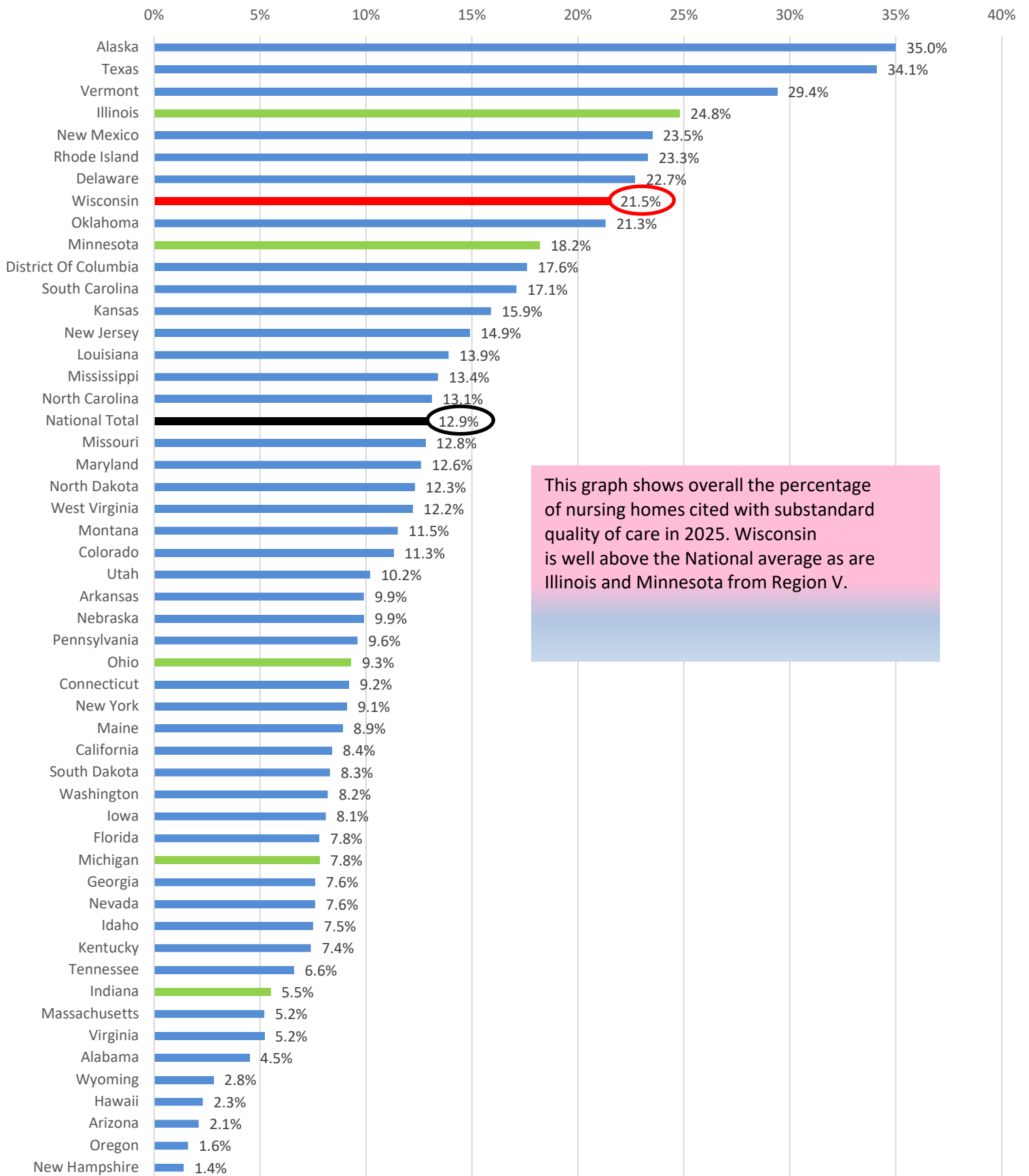
Percentage of 2025 Complaint Surveys Identifying Substandard Quality of Care
