

At the SeniorCare Advisory Committee meeting held on May 11, 2015, the following motion was approved by the committee:

The SeniorCare Advisory Committee opposes the proposed state budget changes to Wisconsin's popular and successful SeniorCare program. The changes would eliminate the simplicity of the program, give up over \$80 million in revenue (federal and rebate), shift over \$80 million in additional out-of-pocket costs to low income elders and eliminate "creditable coverage" for thousands of seniors.

We urge the Joint Finance Committee to maintain SeniorCare as it exists today.
