PURPOSE

This memo has been amended to show the Base (state/Federal) FoodShare Employment and Training (FSET) Program funded amount for Calendar Year (CY) 13 and the reduced amount of 2013 100% FED allocations on the same page. This will allow FSET agencies to see the two funding components side by side and easily calculate the total amount of FSET funding for the year.

The purpose of the original memo was to announce a decrease in 100% federal funding allocations for the FoodShare Employment and Training (FSET) Program for 2013.

INTRODUCTION

Because the federal government is currently operating under Continuing Resolution and negotiations on government spending cuts are continuing, the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) has advised states of a change in funding for 2013. Pursuant to guidance FNS received from the federal Office of Management and Budget (OMB), the funding that was originally approved for 2013 under the 100% Federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Employment and Training (E&T) Program is decreasing. A number of federally funded programs, including the (FSET) program, are impacted by this development. Until a full year appropriation bill is passed, states cannot claim more 100% federal FSET funding than the federal Food & Nutrition Service (FNS) has made available.

Based on current circumstances, the State of Wisconsin intends to release \$908,055 in 100% federal FSET program funds. A decrease in 100% federal funding will be

reflected in the 2013 FSET contracts. If additional funding is released, an amendment will be made to the contract allocating the funds.

FSET allocations are subject to the availability of funding. Although FNS expects it will be able to release additional 100% federal funding to states after Congress takes final appropriations action, there is no guarantee that such additional funding will reach the amounts approved in FSET State Plans.

States have not been advised of any potential changes regarding the amount of federal funds being released to match state funds or to reimburse half of allowable outlays for services funded with local dollars.
