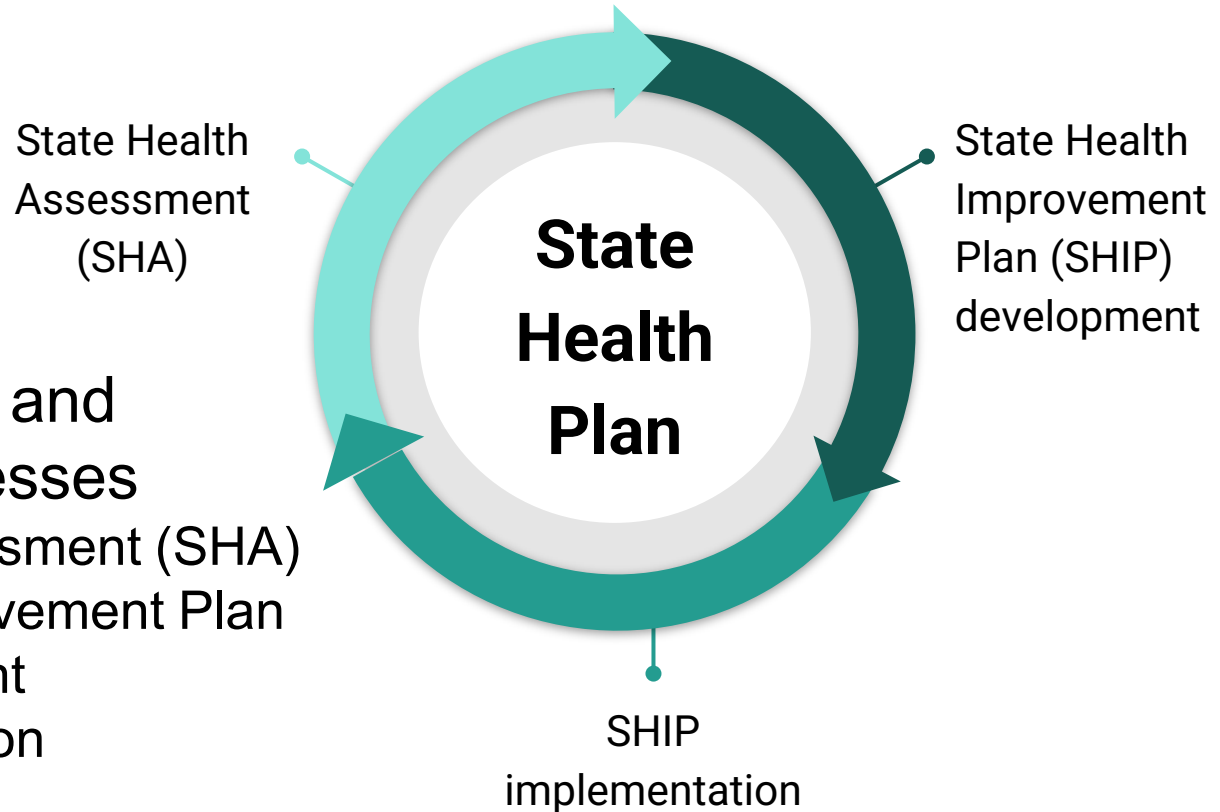
State Health Plan

A “**public health agenda**” created through “a process for planning **to use the resources of the state to meet the health needs of residents** and, in conjunction with other state agencies, to implement the objectives that relate to state government in statutes or in public health rules promulgated by the department. The process shall involve representatives from public health organizations, governmental agencies and the general public.”

- Wis. Stat. § 250.07(1)(a)

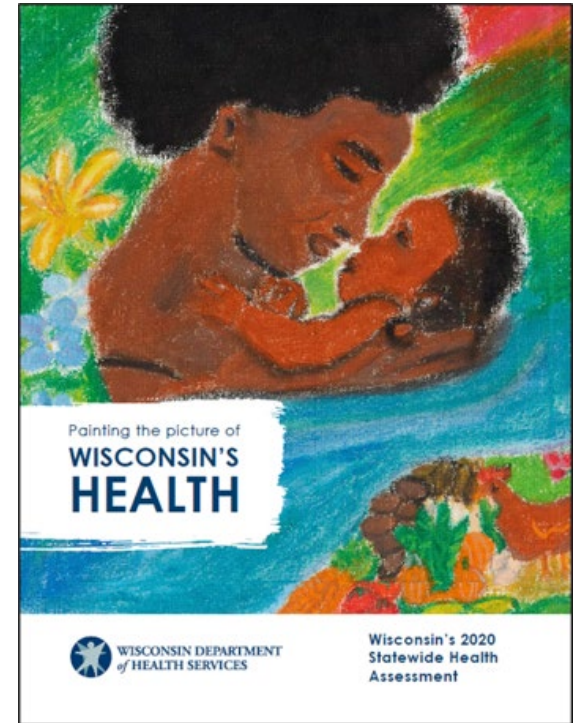
State Health Plan Process

- 5-year cycle
- Series of iterative and overlapping processes
 - State Health Assessment (SHA)
 - State Health Improvement Plan (SHIP) development
 - SHIP implementation



2020 State Health Assessment (SHA)

- Thousands of quantitative data points
- 70+ community conversations
- Other sources of qualitative data
- Results:
 - Significant inequities in health factors and outcomes
 - Increased emphasis on root causes

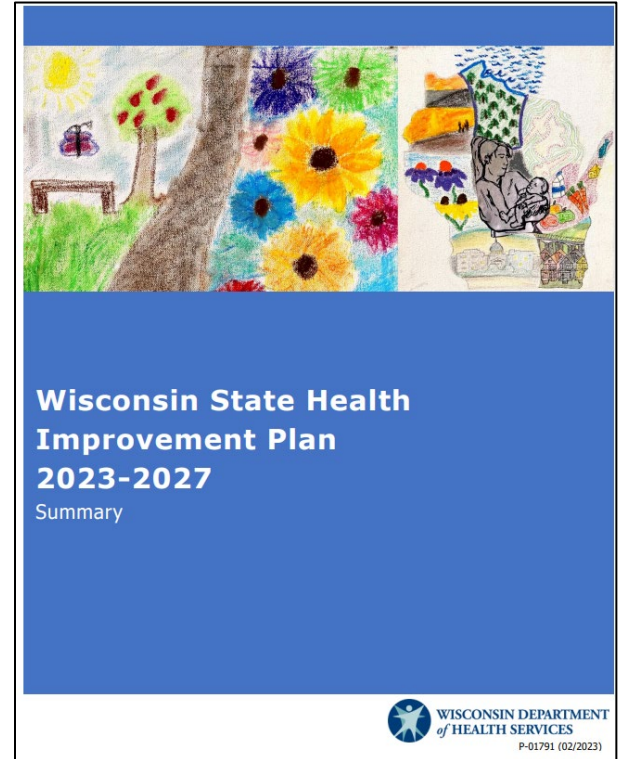
