Review Inclusion Criteria

We cannot change the state inclusion criteria but we can better define it. Included in the registry:

ICD9 codes 800-959.99 (excluding 905-909.9, 910-924.9, 930-939.9).

Same level falls: (see attachment)

What mechanisms of injury (MOI) are excluded r/t same level fall (E885) (slipping, tripping, stumbling):

- nonmotorized scooter, roll/in line skates, skateboard, skis, snowboard.

(E866) fall same level collision/push/shove MOI excluded:

- in sports

Exclude isolated closed distal extremity fracture w/ distal extremity defined as:

- below the elbow; distal radius & ulna is considered one fracture.
- below the knee: distal tibia & fibula is considered one fracture

Example: a fall going downhill on snow skis which results in one distal extremity fracture is not included. If there is an open fracture or trauma activation it will be included.

Inclusion criteria for five states passed around the room and reviewed for what was liked and disliked.

	<p>Drowning / asphyxiation: This is not included in the state registry r/t AIS coding for ISS.</p> <p>If the highest trauma activation is activated at your facility for a hanging then it is included in the registry.</p> <p>Question: Can we change our criteria to meet NTDB standards for inclusion? (see attachment)</p> <p>Mike: We are moving to matching the NTDB registry.</p> <p>Discussion r/t MOI and trauma activations: When there is an activation and the patient goes home from the ED it is not included in the NTDB submission. However, if the patient is considered an admission according to your trauma registry inclusion criteria then it is included.</p> <p>Discussion r/t adopting NTDB criteria for the state registry. Reiterated by Mike that we cannot change our state criteria and that the changes would need to be made by opening up the rules.</p> <p>Discussion: We could start working on meeting the NTDB criteria now so that when the new software updates r/t NTDB are in affect then we will be ready.</p> <p>Question: What will happen when ICD-10 codes are in affect?</p> <p>Mike: There is no definitive time when NTDB will require IDC-10. The NTDS data dictionary inclusion criteria lists ICD-9 and ICD-10 codes.</p> <p>Discussion: r/t moving forward on opening up the rules for changes. Are we putting the trauma system at risk by opening up the rules with the chance that we could lose more than we would gain? What other things may need to be changed when the rules are opened? Should we request STAC to identify and review all items that could benefit from opening the rules?</p>	
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Motion: Ask STAC to open the administrative rules to change the inclusion criteria. Motion was seconded.

Discussion r/t Motion: What do we want to have fixed and how do we fix it?

- Issues r/t inconsistent data collection
- Not clear or easy to understand
- We want our data to be consistent to compare it to other states (consistent with NTDB).

Motion Approved with one nay: to ask STAC to open the administrative rules to change the inclusion criteria.

Discussion r/t transfer out and receiving hospitals both putting the same patient in the registry. Digital Innovation (DI) is supposed to be handling the integration of that.

Per Mike the DI is going to be providing online training "Registry Anywhere". There is no timeline for the completion of the data points being added to the registry by DI. Marianne will send a copy of the algorithm and how it was changed. Mike is asking that everything look at the descriptions and review and define it so we can talk about it in February.

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Defining WI Inclusion/Exclusion Criteria

"Excluding falls from same level resulting in isolated closed distal extremity fracture or isolated hip fracture."

Exclude isolated closed distal extremity fracture – distal extremity defined as:

- Below elbow
 - Distal radius & ulna fracture is considered one fracture
- Below knee
 - Distal tibia & fibula fracture is considered one fracture

ANY OPEN FRACTURE IS INCLUDED

Exclude isolated hip fracture defined as:

- Fracture of the femoral
 - Subcapatal.
 - Basilar neck
 - Intertrochanteric
 - Subtrochanteric

Use these Ecodes to exclude:

- E885: fall on same level from slipping, tripping, stumbling
 - 0 Nonmotorized scooter
 - 1 roller/in line skates
 - 2 skateboard
 - 3 skis
 - 4 snowboard
 - 9 Other
- E886: fall same level collision/push/shove
 - 0 in sports
 - 9 Other

National Trauma Data Standard Inclusion Criteria
