Scope of Work Summary

- GLITC: Nutrition education for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program participants covering a variety of topics related to nutrition and physical activity as related to the Dietary Guidelines for Americans using evidence-based methods at five tribal sites (Bad River, Lac du Flambeau, Red Cliff, St. Croix, Stockbridge-Munsee). In addition, selected tribal sites will provide the Fit Families Program to serve 25 low income children two to four years of age and their families.
- HCN: Ho-Chunk Nation will provide nutrition education to Tribal members living primarily in and around the following Wisconsin communities: Black River Falls, Nekoosa, Wisconsin Dells, Mauston, La Crosse, Tomah and Wittenberg. The overall goal of the Ho-Chunk Nation Nutrition Program continues to be to educate and empower families to make and activity lifestyle changes that will lead to improved health. Specifically, to raise awareness about the principles of obtaining and preparing a balanced diet following USDA Dietary Guidelines, this will assist Tribal Members with healthy weight maintenance and disease prevention.
