<sup>1</sup>Though this report uses the terms "women", we recognize that not all pregnant or postpartum people use female-gendered pronouns, and this data is inclusive of all people who were participating in the program while pregnant, breastfeeding, or postpartum, including women, transgender men and nonbinary-gendered individuals.

<sup>2</sup>Though this report uses the term "breastfeeding" and "breastfed", we recognize that not all lactating people use the term "breastfeeding." Some people may exclusively pump their milk without feeding directly from the breast, and chestfeeding and bodyfeeding are other ways to describe the feeding of human milk to a child. Data on breastfeeding participants is inclusive of all breastfeeding, chestfeeding and human milkfeeding individuals who were participating in the program including women, transgender men and nonbinary-gendered individuals.

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
