    - IRIS Waiver
      - Has been submitted to CMS and we are responding to their questions
    - Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) System
    - Went live with soft launch November 2, 2020
    - Support center is live
  - Geographic Service Regions 9 & 10
    - Added third MCO to region, Inclusa, they will begin April 1, 2021
  - Emergency is still in place so flexibilities continue
    - Guidance around people with disabilities to have visitors in hospitals and other facilities
    - Payments to HCBS providers and nursing homes
  - IRIS Monthly Rate of Service (MROS)
    - Rate for IRIS Consultant Agencies (ICAs) and Fiscal Employer Agents (FEAs) has not been rebased in several years
    - The proposed rates are being reviewed with the ICAs and FEAs
